Director Steward has been away from the office quite a bit lately so I am taking the liberty of replying to your letter of May 13.

We are very happy to hear that you will be an applicant for the Century Farm honors to be awarded this summer. We are enclosing a copy of the requirements for qualification to refresh your memory.

In order to prove that the farm has been in your family continuously for 100 years, and farmed or managed by descendants of the original owner, you should consult the tax rolls or the county assessor in Benton county - that is, of course, if you do not have other proof. As you will note, when you have this information at hand it should be submitted to the county judge of Benton county. He is Judge E. E. Larkin.
