Yamhill county has the oldest farm on the 1970 list. It dates back to 1845 and was founded by N. K. Sitton, great grand-father of the present owners. The farm has been divided three times but still contains 247 acres of the 680 acres settled by its founder.

Two Clackamas county farms and one farm in Linn county date back to 1847.

Baker county is represented by Century Farms this year for the first time since the program was started. It has two farms on the list: Chandler racket and Inc., now 2,700 acres in size and Chandler Herefords, containing all of the original farm; and a 150-acre farm owned by Jessie Osborn Sturgill.

Several of the farms on this year's list contain all of the original acreage and some have original buildings still in use.
