Sir,

Thank you for your letter of inquiry concerning our "century farm". We would appreciate your expertise.

Russel B. Herndon has lived on this farm for 70 years, since he was adopted by Martin and Perle Cummings, at age 5.

The family records show that Martin Cummings was "given 200 acres, at his birth, September 24, 1880, upon being named MARTIN, after Martin (and Mary) Costello" who owned the land.

We do have photo-copies from the Linn County Court House. However, the probated Costello documents are dated 1887. Upon reading the many pages, it becomes very apparent that the 200 acres, and the description thereof, were set aside and apart from all other Costello real and personal property, for MARTIN CUMMINGS. (Would the age of accountability enter into this?)

Martin Cummings purchased more acres. (As he lived and farmed.)

Russel Herndon, the adopted son, has farmed those acres until his retirement two years ago.

At present, our son, Tommy R. Herndon is doing the farming and has added another 50 acres. He will inherit the farm.

We have tried to keep the original appearance, and thru' three generations take great pride in our farm. The crops are changing from corn, wheat and livestock, to grass seeds.

We will be happy to send you the photo-copied legal documents. Also, answer further questions, as we would like to complete this 'bit of history' while we are able.

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Herndon:

Thank you for sending your application for the Dentury Farm Program and the accompanying documents.\*

I have shown all of your materials to Elizabeth Buehler, our Field Historian, and we have to conclude on the basis of what you have sent that your farm will be qualified as a century farm in 1987, but is not qualified this year. We hope you will reapply for the 1990 award period; the forms are not yet available but we will send them to you as soon as they are.

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The basic problem is that since it was apparently legallyp necessary for Mary Jane Costello to will the 200 acres to Martin Cummings upon her death in 1887, the land must not have been legallyiin his possession prior to that time. Even if the land was berbally promised to Martin upon his birth it did not become legally his property until Mrs. Costello's death.

If we can clarify this for you or **pp**ovide additional addistance, please let us know. We do appreciate your interest in the Century Farm Program and very much hope you will apply in 1990.

Thank you also for sending the interesting photo (returned herewith) of Mr. and Mrs. Costello. Our photographic archives librarian is always happy to receive old photos of historical significance, and we hope you will consider donating yours when you meapply. Many thanks!
