My Great Grandfather, MARK Hattan, came to Oregon in 1846. He Homesteaded the original farm in 1847. He divided his land claim among his children. My Grandfather was one of his sons. Grandfather was killed in 1904 and my grandmother and her children farmed our place. It was passed on to my mother in 1940. My parents in turn deeded the place to my family.

At the time Great grandfather lived here Indians still roamed free in our area.

Today we are raising cattle, hogs, and hay on our place. Some of our work is done by ox team that we have raised and trained here.
