
In accordance with your request of August 1, 1973, we are enclosing a set of forms for applying for 1973 Century Farm honors. When you have completed the forms, please mail them directly to Mr. Thomas Vaughan, Director, Oregon Historical Society, 1230 S.W. Park Avenue, Portland, OR 97205. It will have to be the society's decision as to whether or not they can accept your application at this late date.

We are very sorry that your newspaper did not carry the closing date for filing for the honors. You will note from the enclosed copy of the news release, which was issued at the outset of this year's signup, that the closing date for accepting applications was clearly designated as July 27, 1973.

We might explain that this year's signup was a "special" one---done in connection with the observance of the Oregon Historical Society's 100th anniversary. Other than for this special event, the next regular signup time was to have been 1975, as you had been correctly advised.

The Oregon Historical Society, from this point in the program, now takes over the applications and, if applications are found to be acceptable and properly verified as to 100 or more years of continuous family ownership, they proceed with the preparation of the award certificates which will be presented the honorees at a special program at the Oregon State Fair, the date for which is set for August 31. There will be more information on the presentation program and hour as that time nears.
