Gentlemen:

Re: Tax Lot 22, Section 3, Township 1 South, Range 3 East.

Mr. Fred Powell has contacted this office to verify his claim that the property conveyed to Fred J. and Hazel D. Powell by deed recorded December 27, 1945, in deed records of Multnomah County, Oregon, book No. 1000, page 5, has been in continuous ownership by members of his family for one-hundred (100) years in order to prove eligibility for an Oregon Centennial recognition.

Records which this office has examined are as follows:

- (1) Photostatic copy of notification No. 7109 of Jackson Powell's intent to claim a donation of 320 acres. Being a part of Sections 2 & 3, Township 1 South, Range 3 East, dated November 6, 1855, Claim No. 53.
- (2) Photostatic copy of Certificate No. 4548, Claim No. 53, dated January 5, 1875 which certifies to Jackson Powell the description claimed above.
- (3) The original deed from Jackson Powell to Charles N. Powell for a part of his original claim. This deed was recorded December 11, 1885 in book No. 84, page 29.
- (4) The closing account of Estate No. 17404 of Charles N. Powell, deceased, wherein the widow, Carrie Powell, is the heir.
- (5) The photostatic copy of a deed from Carrie Powell Martin, et al to Fred J. and Hazel D. Powell mentioned in first paragraph of this letter.

It would appear that the property does qualify, by being in continuous ownership of the Powell family from November 6, 1855.
