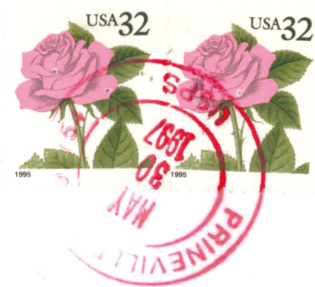

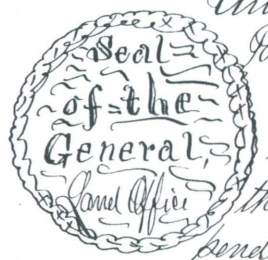

the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereto, unto the said Andrew Jensen  
and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water  
rights for Mining, agricultural, Manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights  
to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be  
recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of  
courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract  
and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or inter-  
sect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law. And there is reserved  
from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals con-  
structed by the authority of the United States.
