Hawkins, a married man, Robert J. Hawkins, a married man, Wray A. Hawkins, a married man, Marjorie June Johansen, a married woman, and Dorothy Joan Scheyer, a married woman, as grantees, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto said grantees forever, as tenants in common (each of said grantees being the owner of an undivided one-sixth interest of the property hereby conveyed in common with the other five grantees), their heirs and assigns, that certain land described on Exhibit A, which is hereto attached, marked Exhibit A, and hereby referred to.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the hereinbefore granted and described property with said appurtenances unto grantees forever, as tenants in common, as in this deed described.

And I, the grantor, do COVENANT to and with said grantees, their heirs and assigns, that the above granted real property is free from all encumbrances, EXCEPTING:

(a) Any rights outstanding due to reservations contained in United States Patents; and any ways created by persons other than grantor and created prior to the date grantor acquired any interest in said property, and of which grantor has no knowledge (and which are not otherwise in this instrument mentioned or listed as being specifically excepted from being covered by the warranty of this instrument). Rights outstanding, if any, for any utility line now openly or visibly existing on or across said property.
