ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

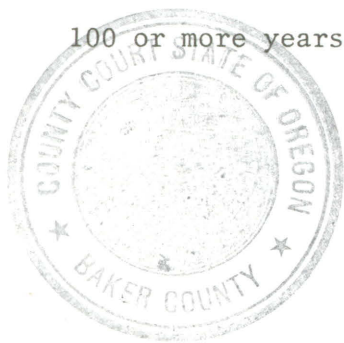
