the following described premises, to-wit: Lot Number four (4) and five (5) of East side Fruit tracts in Marion County State of Oregon as shown by the records of said County

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, with their appurtenances, unto the said Peter Gerig heirs and assigns, forever.

And the said Peter Gerig do hereby covenant to and with the said heirs and assigns, that he the owner in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, and that with warrant and defend the same from all lawful claims whatsoever.
