Whereas Presley King of Wasco County Oregon has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at the Dalles Oregon whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Presley King according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820 entitled "An act making further provisions for the sale of the Public lands" and the acts supplemental thereto for the

East half of the North east Quarter and the east half of the South East Quarter of Section Ten in Township Two South of Range sixteen East of Willamette Meridian in Oregon containing one hundred and sixty acres -

According to the Official Plot of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Presley King -

Now know ye that the United States of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Presley King and to his heirs the said Tract above described. To have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Presley King and to his heirs and assigns forever subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining agricultural manufacturing or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs

rights used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local laws customs & decisions of courts and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law.

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at the Dalles Oregon whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress Approved 20th May 1862 To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain and the acts supplemental thereto the claim of John P. King has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the south west quarter of the north west quarter, the west half of the south west quarter and the south east quarter of the south west quarter of section twelve in Township two South of Range sixteen East of the Willamette Meridian in Oregon containing One hundred and sixty acres according to the official Plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now Know ye that there is therefore granted by the United States unto the said John P King the tract of land above described, to Have and to Hold the Said tract of land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said John P. King and to his heirs and assigns forever subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining agricultural manufacturing or other purposes and rights to ditches and canals used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs laws and decisions of Courts and also subject to the right of a proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted as provided by law.
