

Dear Sir,

I am applying for recognition as an Oregon Century Farm for 1993. My grandfather, Robert W. Pinkerton, purchased this land January 4, 1893, as evidenced by a copy of the Warranty Deed recorded by the Sherman County Clerk on that date. I also submit a Certification of Ownership of Century Farm from one of your older forms, signed by both County Commissioners and our County Judge.

The line of ownership in this property is: (1) Robert W. Pinkerton and Carrie J. Pinkerton, (2) Harry B. Pinkerton and Nina O. Pinkerton, (3) T. Dean Pinkerton and Margaret C. Pinkerton, subdivided in 1979 to Pinkerton Ranch, a family partnership owned by Dean and Margaret and their three children; Bruce R. Pinkerton, Janet Pinkerton VanGilder, and David C. Pinkerton. Each generation has been owner-operators. The farm is currently operated by Pinkerton Brothers, a partnership consisting of Bruce and David Pinkerton--- the fourth generation that has lived on and operated this farm continuously since January 4, 1893.

Warranty Deed.

Know All Men By These Presents

That Alexander D. Mc. Donald and Agnes Mc. Donald his wife in consideration of Sixteen hundred and Eighteen (\$1618⁰⁰) Dollars to them paid by Robert W. Pinkerton do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to said Robert W. Pinkerton his heirs and assigns forever, the following described parcel of real estate, to wit:

The North West quarter (N.W. 1/4) of section thirty two (32) in Township One (1) North Range Seventeen (17) East of the Willamette Meridian in Sherman County and State of Oregon and containing 160 acres.

Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining; and also all our estate right, title and interest, at law and equity therein or therein including dower and right of dower.

To Have and To Hold the same to the said Robert W. Pinkerton his heirs and assigns forever, and we Alexander D. Mc. Donald and Agnes Mc. Donald do covenant with the said Robert W. Pinkerton and his legal representatives forever, that the said real estate is free from all encumbrances; and that we will, and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same unto the said Robert W. Pinkerton his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.
