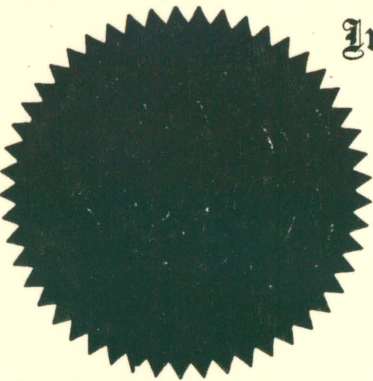

Whereas There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER of the LAND OFFICE at *Oregon City Oregon*, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *John R. Bailey* has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the *North West quarter of Section twenty two in Township three North, of Range four West of Willamette Meridian in Oregon, containing one hundred and sixty acres*

according to the OFFICIAL PLAT of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Now know ye, That there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said *John R. Bailey* the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *John R. Bailey* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.



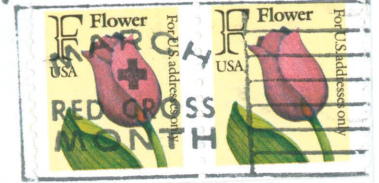

Given under my hand, at the CITY OF WASHINGTON, the *eighteenth* day of *February* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *ninety one*, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and *fifteenth*
