he signed to his son's^{and daughter Nada Dyer.} who now farm.

Rona Sittou his widow lives on the farm
and son's farm + ^{manage} no stock now only grain.
Charles had dairy cows - shep + hogs.

The house built by Scott. is as it was
originally. other buildings have all been
replaced in the past - 50 years.


Margaret Scott married Fred Sittou 1885
(Charles - her son) } ^{this marriage} joining two pioneer
families.
