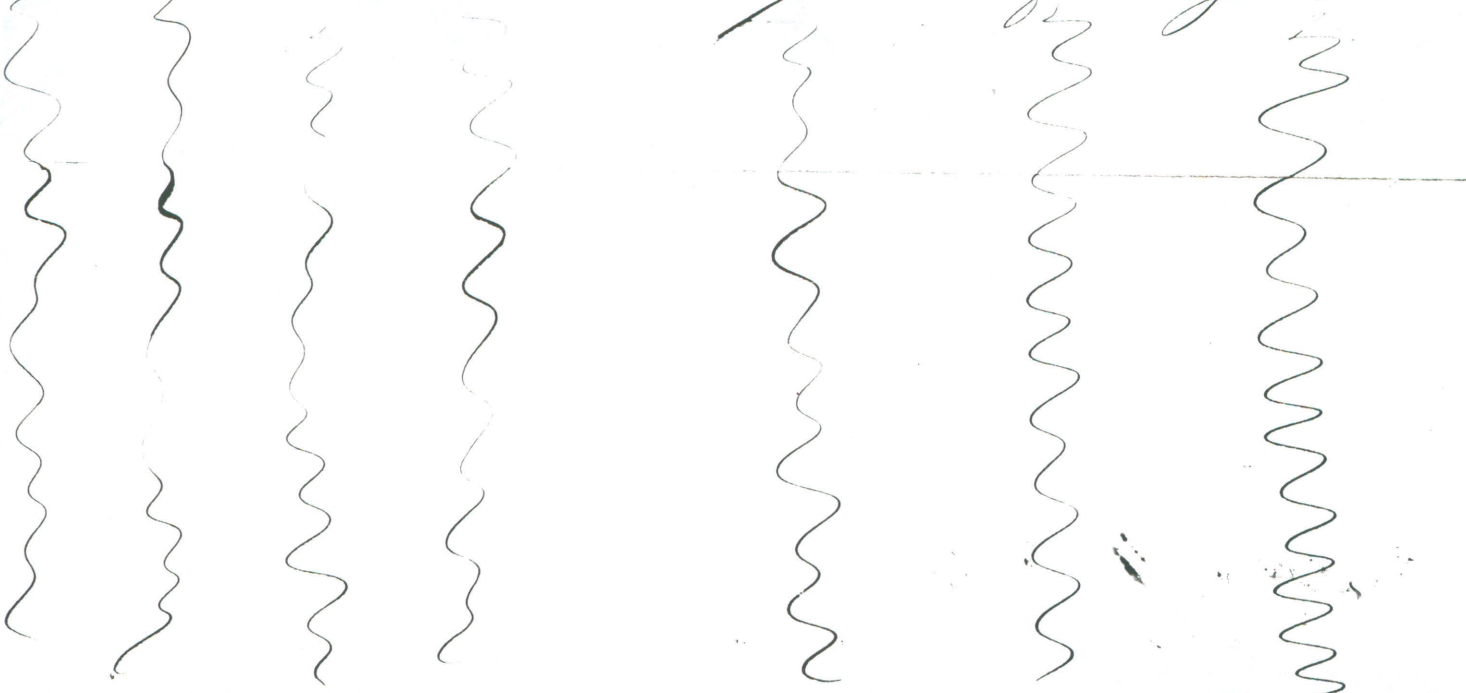

the party of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five hundred DOLLARS, coin of the United States of America, to his hand paid by the said party of the

second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he granted, bargained, sold, conveyed, and confirmed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey, and confirm unto the said party of the

second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever All our right title interest and estate in and to the following described premises to wit:- Beginning at the South west corner of the Donation Land claim of Charles Allen & Wife Claim No 42 Notification 5143 in Sections 20, 21, 28 & 29, T 10 S. R. 6 W. of the Willamett Meridian, thence east 55.98 chains, thence North 19.50 chains, thence west 46.38 chains, thence S. 25° 45' W 21.66 chains to place of beginning, in all containing 100 acres. All situated in Benton County State of Oregon.
