



Louis R. Falk Sr. bought the farm in 1907. He married Anna Falk in 1909. They raised their 9 children on this place. (See pictures attached of children). The children were: Ava, Edna, Charles, Luella, Ardella, Betty Jean, Louis, Delmer, and Stanley.

At the turn of the Century, Louis and Anna Falk grew lots of corn, plowed with horses, and had all the farm animals of the time. The 1930 census listed Louis' occupation as farmer, dairy and grain. November 1935 the local paper, The Brownsville Times listed \$150 damages to the corn dryer, with the assistance of neighbors the fire was extinguished before the entire building and 1000 bushels of corn in the dryer were consumed.

In the 1940 US Census it stated they lived on an owned farm valued at \$6700. When Louis Falk Sr. died in 1955 at his farm, his obituary stated he had lived in the Willamette Valley for 51 years. He had farmed in the Halsey area his entire adult life.

The Falk Family have been known for their ability to grow crops, raise livestock, and built things from both wood and metal. Food is an important part of their lives. Many generations are remembered for their good cooking, smoked meat, and big gardens. Abundance of food at the dinner table is what friends and neighbors recalled. Good cooks in the family are legendary.

You cannot mention the Falk name without people associating it with an avid hunting and fishing history. Deer, pheasants, ducks, elk, and all kinds of fishing.

After returning from World War II Louis R. Falk Jr. and his wife Ina bought part and inherited part of the farm in 1955 and 1969. They raised ryegrass on the land. In the late 1950's Interstate 5 went through ½ mile west of this

farm. It changed the landscape forever. Wildlife patterns changed, water flow drainage ditches were re-routed, and the driving of fast uninterrupted traffic was fascinating to watch. The current light advertisements have lit up our Halsey exit 216 at night and have become a landmark. During Harvest the night lights were always associated with one more round completed as you headed North in the field.

The fruit trees (apple and pear) planted by Louis and Anna Falk still produce fruit for great Grandson Mike Moore and great great grandson Andrew Moore who currently live on the farm.

The original 160 acres still raises ryegrass and is currently owned by Steve and Janna ^{Falk} Moore, Aart and Charlene (Sheri) Falk.
