ART EDUCATION

The Basic Norm for Secondary School Art began in 1965 with 21 students in classes directly related to this program. Of these students 11 enrolled in the School of Education and 10 registered in the School of Humanities and Social Sciences.

Six students begin student teaching during the next three terms.

The methods course for Secondary Art (408n) is well-established and students under the Basic Norm program are receiving instructional value far above the minimal requirements established for certification by the Board of Higher Education.

We expect the Secondary Art program to serve a need that is pertinent to the development of art in Oregon public schools. This program, in structure, is comparable or superior to programs currently in progress in neighboring states, such as California.

Dr. Linderman headed up the program from its inception until the end of June, 1966. Mr. Crozier has headed up the program since the Fall Term, 1966-67.
