We do appreciate the wonderful things you people in America are doing for us, and the gifts of clothes to the blitzed people. I remember your saying to us that you and your husband intended to travel in Europe in a year or two. I wonder how long you will have to wait??? Affairs are looking much brighter now since we have begun our Libyan offensive. It is amazing what flesh and blood ~~can~~ stand!

I am just learning to type, so excuse all mistakes.

I will also write to Mrs Warner, but will send it by a later post

I am ashamed to say I shall not be in time with any of my Christmas letters. I have been moving about lately, so could not settle down to letter writing.

I hope you are well and flourishing also your husband?

I had such a nice letter from Mrs Willard the other day.
