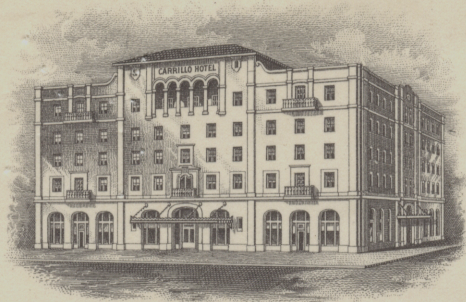
Dear Mrs. Warner. Your letter
