I expected to leave some time either at the end of the summer or before. I have already

been asked to exhibit in Honolulu
Indeed they expect me in March; but
I must try for my Nah Series.

came out 4 years ago.

I want her to meet all my American
friends - she loves all those she
has met so far & I have no doubts
