Prior or December 7, some 35 Japanese students were in attendance at this institution. A number of these have withdrawn voluntarily, and at the present time but 22 are registered.

The interests of these young people have been seriously discussed in a number of occasions. Some members of our faculty participated in a conference of representatives different Pacific institutions recently.

It seems to us desirable to join with other institutions in any uniform procedure which may be worked out. We have been particularly impressed with the proposals which have emanated from the University of California.
