It seems to me that you have provided a history of this fresco which is sufficient for identification purposes.

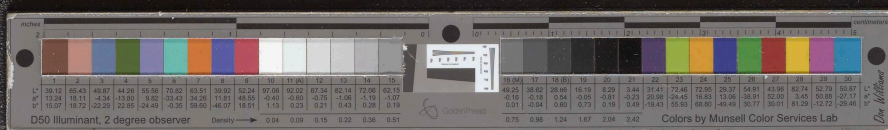
