HONOR GRADUATES, MILITARY DEPARTMENT

On account of the recognized efficiency of the Military Department at the College, the United States War Department permits the institution to name three percent of the graduates who have pursued the training in the Reserve Officers' Training Corps as Honor Graduates, selection being on the basis of their academic standing on the campus and their interest and efficiency in the prescribed military work. One or more of these young men are usually tendered commissions as second lieutenants in the Regular Army, provided they can pass the physical requirements.

The United States Government has established Reserve Officers' Training Corps units in Cavalry, Engineers, Field Artillery, and Infantry at this institution. Few institutions in the United States are so well equipped for efficient military instruction as the Oregon Agricultural College. A small percentage of educational institutions are listed as "Distinguished" on account of unusual efficiency of the Military Department, as determined by the War Department inspectors. This institution has been so classified since 1917, with the exception of two years. All of the graduates who complete the R. O. T. C. course are eligible for reserve commissions provided they are

recommended by the proper college authorities. These commissions insure them of service as commissioned officers in time of war or emergency. The recipients of these commissions have demonstrated their leadership, manhood, and unselfish devotion to the services of the Nation.
