#### Editor's Notebook

Contributions to the OSU Fund for 1965-66 reached an all-time high with over \$47,000 received from more than 4,000 contributors. The previous high was \$40,254 from 3,534 donors in 1962-63. Turn to the OSU Fund Report insert for complete Fund information.

The Board of Directors of the OSU Alumni Association decided at their spring meeting that the cost of a life membership in the association will remain at \$100. They also stipulated that all other lower cost life membership plans be completely phased out by June 30, 1967. What this means is that all those on *other* than the \$100 life membership plan will have to complete their life memberships by June 30 next year. After that date all pending life memberships will be \$100.

Two more great men, and great Oregon Staters, have died. James V. Dixon, a teacher and acting head of the Division of Physical Education, died June 8, 1966; Edward C. Allworth, manager of the Memorial Union for 38 years, June 24, 1966. (See Deaths.)

Jim was a personal friend, teacher and confident, as he was to many other Oregon State men and women. Bob Ingalls, editor of the Corvallis Gazette-Times, wrote: "Jim was intelligent, but not a pseudo-intellectual; tough, but no bully; handsome, but not pretty; friendly, but no backslapper; a leader, but a follower, too; a patriot, but not ostentatious; modest, but no introvert; self-disciplined, but no crusader; opinionated, but tolerant." He was the personification of a real man.

Major Allworth was known, loved and respected by all Oregon Staters. When he joined the faculty in 1925 he served as secretary of the Alumni Association, secretary of the Memorial Union Board of Governors and manager of the Memorial Union. Although the "MU" wasn't built until 1928, the Major was active in drawing plans for the structure and securing donations to finance it.

He was a courageous soldier both on the battlefield and on his own Oregon State campus, where he impressed many as living by the Memorial Union's dedication—"... to the service and inspiration of the living and to the memory of our immortal dead."

This issue of *The Oregon Stater*, because of printing deadlines and OSU Fund report material, is comparatively short with campus and alumni copy. We are striving to update and improve your alumni magazine. If you have any suggestions and constructive criticism, let us know about them.

Coley has hung up old suit No. 1. After 47 years on the Beaver staff—37 years coaching baseball—Ralph O. Coleman retired from the active Oregon State athletic scene. His baseball teams amassed 556 wins while absorbing 303 defeats.

#### **OSU Student Housing**

Students planning to attend Oregon State University this fall are encouraged to make

housing arrangements soon.

Space is still available in the residence halls, according to Thomas F. Adams, but all of the halls are expected to be filled to capacity-or overflowing-by the time school starts Sept. 26.

Early reservations will prevent housing complications for students at the last minute and will help the university better prepare to handle the increased enrollment, Adams

said. He is director of housing.

A fall enrollment approaching 12,700 is expected, compared to 11,906 a year ago.

Three new cooperative houses will be opened this fall, but all of the cooperative houses where the cooperative houses where the cooperative share the cooperativ houses—where students share household chores to reduce living expenses—are already

filled.

All university married student housing also is taken, but the University Housing Office can assist student couples and families find private housing in the Corvallis area. Lists of available houses and apartments are maintained, along with room and board lists for single students.

Freshmen must live in residence halls, cooperatives, or fraternities and sororities. Single sophomores and juniors, under 21, must live in supervised housing either on or off campus; seniors and those over 21 have

free choice of housing.

A new residence hall, the 10th in 10 years, has been started this summer and will be ready for the opening of the 1967 school year. It will accommodate 378 students.

#### **Student Leaders Named**

Ozyegin was ASOSU first vice president

last year.

Also named to student offices were Bob Moore, Corvallis, editor, and Irene Stauss, Corvallis, manager of the OSU Daily Barometer, student newspaper.

Miss Stauss is the first woman in 13 years to be selected for the managerial position.

#### **Barometer Editor Honored**

Robert T. Moore, a senior at OSU, has been named as the "Best Wrestling Writer" for 1966 and winner of the Dellinger Award for his dedicated efforts in promoting the sport. Announcement was made by the national Amateur Wrestling News.

Moore had just completed his first year as editor and co-publisher of *Takedown*, a weekly publication devoted exclusively to

amateur wrestling in Oregon.

Assisted by business manager and co-publisher Tom Roth, a 1966 graduate,

Moore published Takedown for 12 consecutive weeks. Wrestling news, dual meet and tournament results, state ratings, photos and other features were included in the four to eight tabloid pages each week.

Moore and Roth believe they have

#### Large Computer at OSU

The largest computer in Oregon was installed at Oregon State University last June.

The Control Data machine is being housed in Kidder Hall, which is to be the computer center of the University. It will be one of several that will serve the University and eventually the state system of higher educa-tion in research and student instruction.

Eventually, other institutions will have direct contact with the machine and will share in the use of the equipment. Also, the machine will be available to public agencies

and private business.

The Control Data 3300 machine is capable of making about 33,000 additions per second and has about 32,000 words of immediate

access storage

Computer Data, from whom the equipment is leased, will provide two full-time engineers to maintain the operations and mechanical functions. Robert A. Walan is computer engineer, and Robert Rubin is customer engineer.

The center is under Dr. D. D. Aufenkamp,

director.

#### Space Science Dictionary

The first dictionary of space science terms for elementary school age children will be prepared at Oregon State University during

the next two years.

The work is being done for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, which has granted the university \$16,000 to cover necessary research and preparation of a dictionary that is expected to contain about

500 to 750 words.

Project leader will be Dr. Stanley E. Williamson, head of the Science Education department and president in 1963-64 of the National Science Teachers Association. Williamson has served earlier as a member of editorial advisory boards for dictionaries of illustrated science and natural sciences.

The space science dictionary for young people will place special emphasis on grades

four through six.

It will include important words directly related to space exploration science, their pronunciation, definition, and correct use of each term in a sentence. Illustrations will be used where essential to give words greater clarity or to amplify meaning.

Elementary school children have a natural interest in space science but lack of ac-curate, simplified definitions of many space science terms often leads to improper understanding of events or to the development of inaccurate concepts in this area, Dr. William-

son said.

He will be assisted in the work by selected doctoral candidates in science education who have had experience as classroom teachers and by two university specialists in reading education—Dr. Ned Marksheffel and Dr. Anne Lasswell.

#### **Coed Engineers**

Six coeds studied engineering at Oregon State last spring term and established some

One of them, Julie Latham of Medford, who received a bachelor's degree in general engineering, is the first woman admitted to study for a master's degree in engineering.

A junior from Lakeview, Shirley Ann Hansen, will graduate in 1967 with a degree in

electrical engineering.

The other four are freshmen. They are: Keliata Ann Layman, Klamath Falls, who is studying mechanical engineering; Toby Ann Levy, Cornelius, general engineering; Karen Marie Stanclift, Merced, Calif., agricultural engineering; and Linda Mary Thomas, Portland, general engineering.

Miss Stanclift is the first coed ever to en-

roll in agricultural engineering.

George Gleeson, dean of the School of Engineering, said there are about 1,000 women enrolled in engineering schools in the country as compared to more than 242,000 men.

Women engineers, Dean Gleeson said, earn a higher salary than most other professional women. Like the men, they start at about \$600 to \$650 on their first job out of

Job opportunities are particularly good for women in such fields as computer program-ming, home designing, technical publications, engineering library work and as technical secretaries.

#### **OSU Foundation News**

Frank Ramsey of Corvallis, president of the Timber Access Industries Company, and chairman of the Alumni Association's OSU Fund annual giving program, was elected president of the Oregon State University Foundation. He succeeds W. Del Ball, Tigard auto dealer.

Jack Brandis of Portland, president of the Brand-S company, extensive lumber and plywood operation in the Northwest, was chosen as vice president. Dr. James H. Jensen, president of OSU, will continue as secretary and Amby Frederick, Portland, director of the Medical Research Foundation of Oregon, was reelected treasurer.

Joseph H. Berry of Corvallis remains as executive secretary, and John Fenner, Corvallis attorney, was continued as the other member officer of the board's executive

committee.

Fifteen trustees were re-elected for three-year terms. Dean Walter McCulloch of the OSU School of Forestry was named as a

new trustee.

Outgoing president Del Ball announced that assets of the OSU Foundation had increased by \$137,000 during the past year. The newly-developed deferred giving program has grown to potential support of the excellence-in-education program of approximately \$3,420,000, he said.

#### **Faculty News Notes**

Fred J. Burgess has been designated as the new head of the Department of Civil Engineering at Oregon State. He succeeds Glenn W. Holcomb, who retired after 46 years on the OSU faculty.

The new department head is a national leader in sanitary engineering, waste treatment and water resources

Burgess joined the OSU faculty in 1953 and has been professor of civil engineering, assistant to the dean of engineering, and chairman of the University's Water Resources Research Institute.

He received his bachelor's degree from OSU in 1950 and a master's degree and special award in sanitary engineering from Harvard University.

Dr. Leonard A. Adolf, OSU history professor, has been awarded a Fullbright-Hayes grant to lecture on American history this coming school year at University of Saigon in Vietnam.

The award was made by the State Department under the Mutual Educational and Cultural Exchange Act of 1961, designed to assist in the development of "friendly, sympathetic and peaceful relations between the United States and other countries of the

Adolf has been on the OSU faculty since 1955. He earlier won one of the all-university outstanding teacher awards and was among the 47 OSU winners of \$1,000 excellence in teaching awards, provided by the last Legis-

#### Jobs Plentiful, Applicants Scarce for OSU June Graduates

Although more employing organizations had scheduled interviews for 1966 college graduates than ever before, the response of applicants was appreciably less.

Louis Edwards, placement director for OSU's business school, believes the air of indecision surrounding the military commitment situation caused students to take a dim view of their immediate future and discouraged many from interviewing.

More young men are seeking officer candidate school opportunities, with an eye on military service. Others have enlisted in the service of their choice.

The existing conditions have made it somewhat better for women in the job market, making them prospective candidates for positions previously held my men.

Compared to two years ago, minimum starting pay for 1966 graduates at the bachelors level is up \$1,000 a year.

For the bachelors degree graduate, salaries ranged from \$5,000 to \$6,600 a year, depending upon the field of study.

For the masters degree graduate, pay ranges from \$7,000 to \$11,000. Doctorate degree candidates accepted offers from \$8,500 to \$11,000.

Universities are competing with industry for many of the advanced degree candidates. If a doctors degree graduate accepts a university position it usually means about \$2,000 less in annual salary.

The job outlook by OSU schools of study

follows:

Science: Positions in science fields such as entomology, botany, oceanography, microbiology, zoology, biochemistry, statistics, ge ology and geography have reached an alltime high, a trend that is likely to continue.

There is a greater stress towards specialized qualifications which reflects growth of research opportunities and of advanced work in colleges and industries.

Shortage fields in microbiology exist in virology, immunology, aerobiology, petroleum icrobiology and sanitary microbiology.

In geology, for example, the doctor of

philosophy graduate will get about \$8,500 to \$9,300 a year in a university position, but \$11,500 a year with an oil company.

In entomology, for the bachelors degree holder, there are numerous positions open for county sanitarians and for inspectors with the U.S. Food and Drug Administration and with chemical companies. Starting pay is \$6,000 to \$6,600.

Engineering: Electrical engineering field

is the shortest with mechanical engineering second.

For example, electrical engineering graduates with a bachelors degree start at about \$670 a month; masters, \$800; and doctors, \$1,000 to \$1,200. Civil engineers with a bachelors degree start at \$650 a month, the lowest of the engineering fields. Industrial, mechanical and chemical engineers receive slightly higher starting salaries.

Forestry: Forest management, forest engineering and forest products are all shortage fields. Demand is greater than last year and job vacancies cannot begin to be filled. Bachelors degree pay is \$500 a month; masters, \$550; and doctors, start at \$700.

There is a marked decrease in recruiting by the U. S. Forest Service and the Bureau of Land Management, but a corresponding increase in contacts from private industry and state agencies. The School of Forestry expects an increase in federal agency employment in the next few years.

Pharmacy: After completing the five-year course for a bachelors degree, about 10 percent of the graduating class will enter graduate or medical school. Others accept professional pharmacy positions in hospitals, clinics and retail pharmacy or with a pharmaceutical industry.

Oregon law requires one year of intern experience before licensing as a pharmacist. Intern pay is from \$450 to \$650 a month.

Education: Excellent opportunities for graduates prepared to teach in elementary and secondary schools. Men teachers are particularly wanted.

Biggest demands for high school teachers this year appear to be in advanced physics and mathematics, industrial arts, girls physical education, foreign languages, agricultural education, and English.

Many requests have been received for teachers prepared to work with retarded and handicapped children and to be girls

Beginning teachers with a bachelors degree earn about \$5,200 to \$5,500 in Oregon.

Home Economics: Starting pay varies from \$5,000 to \$6,300 for the bachelors degree graduate going into teaching or home economics extension work. A masters degree will bring \$8,000. Shortage fields are teaching in community colleges, and part-time jobs for the homemaker with adult education programs.

Home ec grads entered executive training programs with retail department stores in Honolulu, Portland, Seattle and San Francisco: twice as many graduates as in former years will participate in dietetic internship programs

With the federal Head Start Program to begin soon, the School of Home Economics anticipates a great need for nursery school teachers. Requests for Peace Corps home economists in South America, India and Africa go unfilled.

Inauguration of the Medicare program will bring an increased demand for dieticians, especially for nursing homes. These will be excellent part-time jobs for married home ec grads.

Business and Technology: Greatest demand has been for sales personnel. Accounting and general management remained high, too. Demand for graduates in finance is about the same as the last two years, but the number of candidates responding, particularly for banking, was at a high point.

The law of supply and demand has caused considerable degree of "market place scrambling" for business graduates. Over-all increases are up \$15 to \$25 a month, making the starting salary average more than \$525.

The few persons completing their work for the master of business administration degree in this first year of the program have been receiving offers ranging from \$700 to \$775 a month.

Humanities and Social Sciences: Grads in sociology, psychology and anthropology are in demand for social agency and welfare work as well as with youth agencies with salaries starting at \$5,000 a year.

Students of political science, history and economics who have taken a foreign language are sought for government jobs paying \$5,200 to \$6,300 a year. High school teaching, newspaper work, TV and radio jobs, and public relations positions await graduates who have taken the necessary teacher-certification, speech or journalism courses.

Many humanities and social sciences graduates are awarded scholarships or fellowships to continue on for an advanced degree

Agriculture: No shortage areas and no over-crowded areas are reported for the agriculture graduate. Bachelors degree holders are offered between \$450 to \$550 a month in banking, chemical industries, economics forecasting, journalism, insurance, teaching and

Pay for the masters candidate is between \$600 and \$700 and for the doctor of philosophy degree, \$700 to \$800.





### Fertile Sterility and Dr. Bone's White Rats

Sterile rats are fertile at the laboratory rat colony in the OSU Physics-Chemistry building. Nature's laws have not collapsed, however, for the sterility in question pertains to everything except the animals' procreative powers.

This colony of sterile—i.e., germfree—white rats is the materialization of several years' effort exerted by Dr. Jesse F. Bone, an associate professor in the School of Agriculture's Department of Veterinary Medicine. During long-term nutritional experiments with laboratory rats several years ago, Dr. Bone was disconcerted by the prevalence of diseases in the animal specimens. The diseases, predominantly lung infections, caused fatal illness in numerous animals before termination of the feeding experiments and this, accordingly, impaired the experiment's conclusions.

Presence of bacteria were deterrents to maximum research efficiency in Bone's work, and he knew that a few research centers east of the Mississippi river were rearing laboratory animals free of all bacteria. Therefore, the appeal of using such animals in his work increasingly nagged at him. After attending a national meeting of experimental biologists in 1959 during the peak of his nutritional experiments, Bone determined that Oregon State,

too, must have a colony of germfree laboratory animals.

While vacationing the following summer, Dr. Bone visited every major germfree installation in the country at that time. First hand knowledge acquired from these visits increased his understanding of the problems involved in operating a germfree colony, and also increased his determination to initiate one here. As a consequence, he spent a portion of his spare time during the next four years organizing plans and trying to secure financial backing for the undertaking. Finally, he succeeded in gaining support from the National Institutes of Health. Last July, while he was completing a sabbatical leave in Egypt, his efforts were consummated by the arrival from the East Coast of several pairs of germfree rats, housed in germfree isolator units.

Inside these small plastic homes the pampered rodents breathe sterile filtered air, drink sterile water, eat sterile food supplemented with sterile vitamins, sleep on sterile bedding, and frolic on sterile playgrounds. And should they succumb from so much kindness, their sterile bodies would not decompose, but would mummify. A certain amount of enzymatic action persists for a short period after death, causing a nominal amount of tissue erosion, but the total absence of bacteria precludes both odor and decay. The tissues re-

main pure in death as in life.

Earliest beginnings of the germfree idea go back to 1865 when Louis Pasteur developed the germ theory of disease. Two years later, Lister introduced the principal of antiseptic surgery and, in 1870, Pasteur disproved spontaneous generation when he completely sterilized laboratory apparatus with heat. Scientists soon realized that bacteria are normally present everywhere. They cause disease only when they are stronger than the tissues they invade; that is, if the body has been unable to build up resistance against them due to excess virulence of the bacteria, or if bodily tissues lose their vitality.

Researchers then sought to discover whether a beneficial relationship might perhaps exist between germs and other life forms. Thus, from 1885 onwards, research workers in Europe, Asia and the United States attempted to raise various species of plants and animals under germfree conditions. This proved to be a difficult task with only minor success. It was a quarter of a century before the first animal forms were raised to maturity.

In 1919, Baumberger of Harvard University discovered that germfree flies live longer than conventionally raised flies, but he later learned that they needed supplementary Vitamin B in order to thrive. At last, in 1946, the first germfree mammal—a caesarian delivered monkey—was raised to maturity under the charge of J. A. Reyniers of Notre

Dame University. While the monkey's mother was not a germfree animal, a sterile condition exists within the pregnant womb. Being surgically delivered and placed immediately in a sterile environment, the baby monkey never came into contact

with any bacteria.

Maintaining germfree conditions is a demanding task because the hermetically-sealed isolator may not be opened even for feeding the animals or removing their wastes. Various types of isolators have been used. Here at Oregon State, special devices are built into each unit for ministering to the animals. One serves as a passageway for supplies and two others are a pair of arm-length, heavy-duty rubber gloves which, when not in use, lend a science fiction effect to the unit for they resemble huge, dark antennae jutting out from its surface.

The passageway is a complexly structured germicidal lock to which the technician attaches a cylinder containing the rats' supply of food, water and vitamins which have been sterilized under steam pressure. Utmost care must be employed in this area to prevent admittance of a single germ. When the technician inserts his arms into the gloves, they invert inside the unit so that he can open the inner seal of the lock, remove the supplies from the cylider and reload the cylinder with the wastes.

Weekly bacterial checks are taken from the waste products to determine whether the germfree condition is being maintained. Should a culture prove positive, the entire unit must be discarded for no method exists to sterilize a living animal. Clarence Porter, a research assistant, is the technician currently in charge of OSU's germfree animals. He indicates that some contaminations have occurred during the first few months of operation, but he has maintained one group throughout a 156-day experimental period. At present, Porter has three functioning units. One holds five female rats being used for breeding purposes. The other two units contain animals being fed various levels of specific pesticides in connection with the OSU Federal Core Grant "Pesticides in the Environment."

Care of these ultra-hygienic rodents is more costly than for normal rats due to the elaborate equipment required, but Dr. Bone says the expense is warranted by the saving in researchers' time and the number of animals used. Only about one tenth as many germfree animals are usually required for any experimental series.

Present facilities at Oregon State permit a maximum of only 16 isolator units, but because of the opportunities for more sensitive experiments that germfree specimens can offer, Dr. Bone and his colleagues believe the facility will grow rapidly and play an important role in biomedical research.


