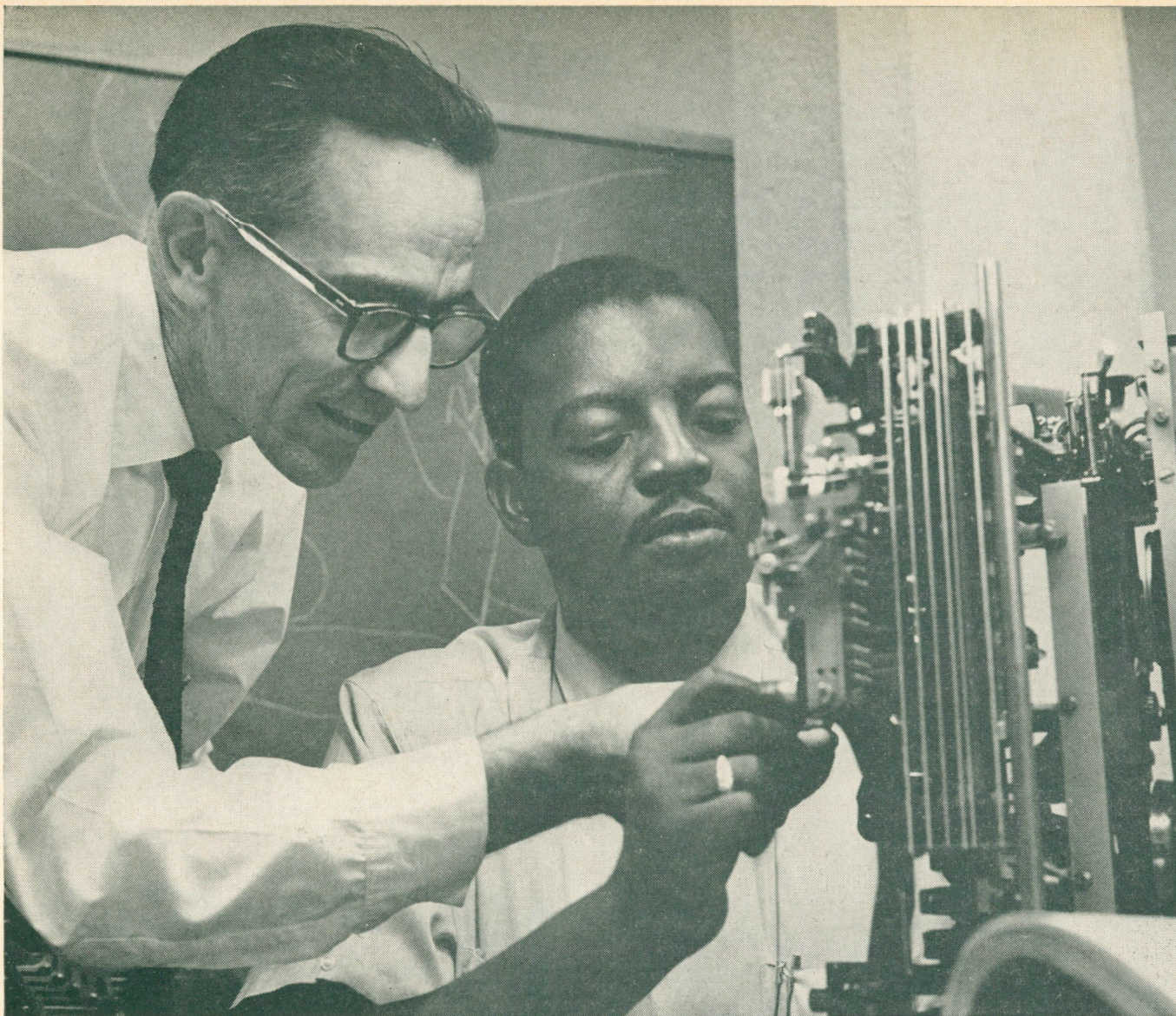

Henry Albert Louz, shown at right in the picture above, is a communications technician from Paramaribo, Surinam (Dutch Guiana).

Mr. Louz is one of approximately 150 foreign nationals from two dozen different countries receiving technical training from the Bell Telephone System this year. NEWS OF THE CAMPUS

This issue of The Oregon Stater includes the 1961-62 Fund Report and is being sent to 30,000 alumni. The enclosed return Fund envelope is for your convenience in making your gift to the '62-'63 Fund.

Final plans are now being readied for new oceanography, radiation center, and computer center buildings totaling \$1,771,780 after the state emergency board approved preliminary plans on August 31.

Construction on all the new buildings is expected to get underway during the coming school year. The oceanography building will be a \$666,500 structure; radiation center, \$755,280; computer center, \$350,000.

The buildings represent highly important additions to the research and teaching programs of OSU and emphasize the position of the university as a great teaching and research center.

The four story oceanography building will be built on the corner of 27th and Orchard streets. The computer center will be constructed as a wing extending to the east from the present Kerr library, which will become a classroom and research building when the new library is finished next fall. The radiation center will be located on 35th street near the site of the regional water quality research laboratory to be built soon by the U. S. Public Health Service.



Oceanography building to be constructed soon will be four stories high and will cost \$666,500.

College Bowl Bound

Oregon State will send its four varsity scholars into General Electric College Bowl action on November 25. The program originates from CBS television studio 52 in New York City and is seen nationally from 5:30 to 6 p.m.

OSU's opponent will be picked from one of the following schools—University of Ari-

zona, Brooklyn College, Catholic University of America, and Manhattanville.

The quiz program draws questions from history, literature, philosophy, science, mathematics, economics, current affairs, music, art, mythology, and the Bible. OSU's varsity scholars are now being chosen from the student body. A faculty and student committee of 11 will do the preparation for the program.

Big Conference

OSU was host in late August to 7,000 scientist and their families from all 50 states, eight Canadian provinces and 18 foreign nations when the annual meeting of the American Institute of Biological Sciences met in joint session on campus with the Pacific Division of the American Association for the Advancement of Science.

The program was the largest scientific gathering held in the Pacific Northwest. A total of 2,144 original research reports were presented.

Campus and city housing facilities were jammed, OSU's armory was transformed with a new paint job and a canvas floor into the convention's headquarters. Dr. Roy Young, head of the departments of botany and plant pathology, was general chairman.

rollment hit a new record of 9,039. Along with the booming enrollment the university is in the midst of the greatest building year in its 95 year history.

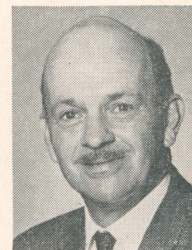

The first year at Oregon State University has been a busy one for President James H. Jensen.

OSU's busy president chats about the campus, the state, and Oregon higher education

IT WAS THE second day of the second year for President James Jensen, August 23rd.

For over a year now the man who had accepted the demanding job of occupying the presidential chair in Commerce building, room 101, had directed the complex workings of a modern university.

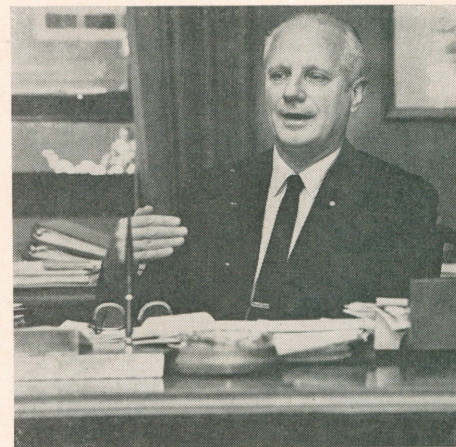
The year just past had been one of tremendous change and responsibility. Two new deans of schools had been appointed, department heads had been selected, new buildings had been erected and planned, the new School of Humanities and Social Sciences was beginning to be felt in a big way on campus. Government grants for research and buildings were soaring to new records. Maintaining a good faculty continued to be a major problem as always and a bulging student enrollment of 9,036 was pounding on university doors.

All this and other pressing problems added up to what can be mildly be called a "busy year."

The start of the second year saw nothing that would change the pattern of the first year for Dr. Jensen. If anything, there would be increasing areas of concern for Oregon State and Oregon higher education.

When President Strand stepped down from the presidential chair and President Jensen occupied the office there weren't too many noticeable changes. A squeak in the floor boards of the outer reception office was happily silenced and new carpeting put down. The mantle of responsibility had shifted smoothly and easily to the shoulders of OSU's new head man.

Not everyone on campus can tell you what it is a president does and how he spends

his day. Those close to the presidential office will tell you that many times President Jensen is at work early in the morning and he quits the office long after the secretaries leave.

The number of conferences, meetings, speeches for a president both on and off the campus is appalling. Much of the time, public relations for the university fall squarely in the lap of its president.

So the second day of the second year was somewhat typical. There was the huge national meeting of the American Institute of Biological Sciences with some 7,000 scientists and families ready to descend upon the campus. A first unit of the new forest research laboratory was to be dedicated that day and Dr. Jensen would be one of the speakers.

With consideration, President Jensen consented to an interview with The Oregon Stater magazine to reflect on his first year as president. It was 9:15 a.m.

What were the most significant events at OSU during the past year?

"It is difficult to evaluate this," Dr. Jensen said, carefully mulling the question. "The first thing of paramount importance was the more than 9,000 students who showed up

and that the staff took it upon themselves to accommodate this 1,000 increase in the student body. There was a hospitable feeling about trying to help out."

As President Jensen spoke about his family's reception in Oregon the words "hospitable" and "friendly" cropped up repeatedly.

"Everyone has been most kind," Dr. Jensen continued. "There has been a real warmheartedness in the community. I have met with small and large groups and it has been a wonderful experience."

He shifted in his chair and began to recall silently the events of the past year, the places in Oregon he had visited, and the names and faces he had matched up.

"The things that make Oregon different are the people, the unusual diversity of climate and topography, and the variances in concentration of population."

Dr. Jensen remarked that he had visited all counties but one. Thinking about this he checked a map of Oregon and amended his remark to include all the counties of Oregon. Yes, he had visited the remote southeast county of Oregon—Malheur county.

To someone who had spent nine years previously in Iowa the question came up

about the famous Western Oregon winter rains.

"The rains are modest—especially to someone who has spent three years in the West Indies. The winter was mild and the summer has been pleasant. We appreciate the flowers throughout the year."

With these pleasantries out of the way, Dr. Jensen got down to the subject that probably concerns him most—the students.

"I knew of the reputation of Oregon State before coming here—the very wholesome and excellent reputation. I have been impressed with the students' freshness, their mannerliness and politeness."

He thought a moment about OSU students, trying to pinpoint some other characteristics and then added: "Another thing is the lack of interest in fads. Be careful how you say this," Dr. Jensen warned good naturedly. "because the first thing they would do would be to say—we'll see about that."

Dr. Jensen reached for his pipe and thoughtfully tapped in a bowlful of tobacco and then lighted it.

"This freshness and wholesomeness in our students—these are the things we should fight to preserve. But in keeping with the times there will be changes. This we can't prevent. We have to live with the world as it is."

President Jensen is obviously impressed with the student body because he told of two national secretaries of fraternities who had visited the campus.

"They both mentioned the wholesomeness of our students. Our fraternity and sorority system is tops scholastically and in activities."

President Jensen speaks quietly but emphatically and occasionally breaks out with a wrinkles-about-the-eyes smile. One thing he doesn't smile too much about is the future and the role of higher education in Oregon and the United States.

"The greatest and most valuable industry in Oregon and the U. S. is higher education," he said seriously. "It provides opportunity for the people. Only through education can we staff the industries, farms, and professions of our rapidly changing civilization."

Dr. Jensen was obviously warming up to his subject as he gestured with his finger: "The U. S. system is without parallel—this is the special ingredient added to the American scene. All nations—even Russia—are copying our higher education. The wide variety—private, church supported, and state

—is one of the desirable things of our higher education.”

Higher education in Oregon will present many problems to Dr. Jensen and other leaders of the state in the future. And the President can reel off an impressive array of facts and figures which do not look comforting.

“This is worthy of note,” he said, “In 1962 in Oregon, there are 48,000 people working toward a baccalaureate degree. By 1972 that number will be 85,000. And if the proportion of the college age group continues to increase as it has in the past there will be 110,000 by 1972. Oregon’s problem is to provide the resources to permit the education of the young people 10 years from now.

“Our problem is that we have to add to our enrollment almost every year the equivalent of a Willamette University or a Lewis and Clark. Unless we can continue the proper financial support, our standards will be lowered.

“One of the big problems is staff. Most of the staff like Oregon. They like Corvallis and they like their work. But they also have families to support and their own children to educate. Salaries are important.”

The president’s telephone rang quietly in the big room and he talked briefly with his secretary.

Then he continued: “Over the years we’ve maintained a 20 to 25 percent level of out-of-state students as compared with in-state students. We would like to hold this. Our schools are maintained largely for Oregon citizens. Of our in-state students in the freshman class,” he noted, “79 percent had a 2.5 grade average or better. Our philosophy is to keep the opportunity for higher education open to all worthy students.”

One of the new developments within Oregon is the community college.

“They are nothing new in the U. S.,” he said. “We welcome them to Oregon. They will give added opportunity for higher education for young people. I have two apprehensions. One is that the community college standards remain high and of collegiate caliber. Two—that the people realize that community colleges are going to cost as much per student to support as other colleges. The main saving will be that students can live at home.

“Our enrollment will not decrease because of community colleges. There will be more students at the junior, senior and graduate levels coming to Oregon State as the community colleges provide more first and second year education. And costs per student will go up at OSU because it is more expensive to educate students at the junior-senior-graduate level.”

The president was then asked about the athletic program at Oregon State. It was obvious that since Jensen had come to OSU and President Flemming to Oregon and Chancellor Lieuallen had been appointed, that there had been a meeting of the minds at the presidential level at the two big state schools.

“Oregon State and the University of Oregon will march together,” Dr. Jensen firmly stated. “If we go into any conference it will be in full partnership.

“We are very anxious to develop rules which admit students and athletes on a par with the University of Oregon and other West Coast institutions,” the President stated. “Our academic requirements are high and we want our athletic teams to be composed of good students and good athletes. Oregon State has an excellent reputation in intercollegiate athletics.”

Dr. Jensen pointed out that there will probably be a sharpening of the evaluation of out-of-state grade requirements.

What are the strong and weak points of Oregon State?

“OSU is strong in the broad educational opportunities in the various fields, the excellence of the staff, and the deep interest of service to higher education.

“Our weak points would have to be the overloads given the staff because of high

public relations picture for the university, and the ability of alumni and friends to support Oregon State programs.

“We need money from alumni for scholarships, loan funds, equipment purchases, faculty improvement,” he said emphatically. “At times we need to hire people with certain talent for short periods of time—such as an architect for the campus.

“Oregon State can use money from alumni to allow the faculty to travel to national meetings. You know,” he said, “we are on the periphery of the nation and most of the outside travel to meetings is quite far.

“We need publications explaining our work and the news of the institution. And not the least is the maintenance of an alumni office to maintain address lists, gather alumni news, and for a center of information for questions of alumni.

“Undesignated funds from alumni to the OSU Fund would make possible the development of a good program into a superior program. We are set up in the Foundation

student enrollment and the difficulty of obtaining appropriations sufficient to meet rapidly rising demands. We must describe the problems of higher education to the legislature and the people of the state.”

President Jensen believes that the state must broaden the revenue producing base so that adequate support is given higher education.

“This does not necessarily mean a sales tax,” the president pointedly made clear, “but we must broaden our revenue base.”

The phone rang again close to Dr. Jensen’s elbow and he swiveled to answer it. One could also hear voices of waiting people in the outer office.

Throughout the past year President Jensen had met with alumni throughout Oregon and in other states. He had studied quietly, no doubt, the operation of the alumni office, the publications and information sent out, the

to accept large gifts to the institution and to assist in wills,” the President said.

There were other questions to ask President Jensen but the phone rang again and the voices in the next room grew in number as more people waited to see the man in room 101. It was 10 a.m.

The second day of the second year for the President continued in the flurry of activity and demand.

President Jensen had commented that he had found some time to fish for salmon at Newport and for steelhead in the Alsea river, but he said he really hadn’t done too much of that. The closest he had come to pursuing a hobby the past busy year was his woodworking and in that he had time only to near the completion of a workbench.

Perhaps there would be more time during the second year.

But he really didn’t sound too hopeful.

NEWS OF ALUMNI

Two Oregon Staters with the name of Sears were in the news recently. **Vic Sears, '41**, All-American first team tackle choice in 1940, has been named to the Helms Major League Football Hall of Fame. He played 11 years of professional football for the Philadelphia Eagles and one of the standout pro linemen of that time. He is the first OSU alumnus to receive the Hall of Fame honor.

Dr. Ernest R. Sears, '32, famed wheat geneticist with the U. S. Department of Agriculture, stationed at the University of Missouri, visited the campus in August for the American Institute of Biological Sciences meetings and to present two papers before the Genetics Society of America. Four years ago Dr. Sears won the \$10,000 Hoblitzelle Foundation award for his successful transfer to wheat of the hereditary leaf-rust resistance of a wild grass.

When Telstar, the world's first active communications satellite, was successfully launched into orbit on July 10, four Oregon State alumni received credit for playing a prominent part in its development.

A. A. Lundstrom, '28, was in charge of design and development of the horn antenna direction system used to track the satellite and predict its orbit at the space communications ground station at Andover, Maine.

A. K. Bohren, '30, was responsible for development and design of the huge 340-ton

Telstar satellite antenna at the Andover ground station.

Edward W. Houghton, '36, supervised a Bell laboratory group that devised a microwave power monitor for the Telstar satellite. **Dean Gillette, '48**, directed a group working on the mathematics, automatic control systems and digital computing connected with the Telstar project.

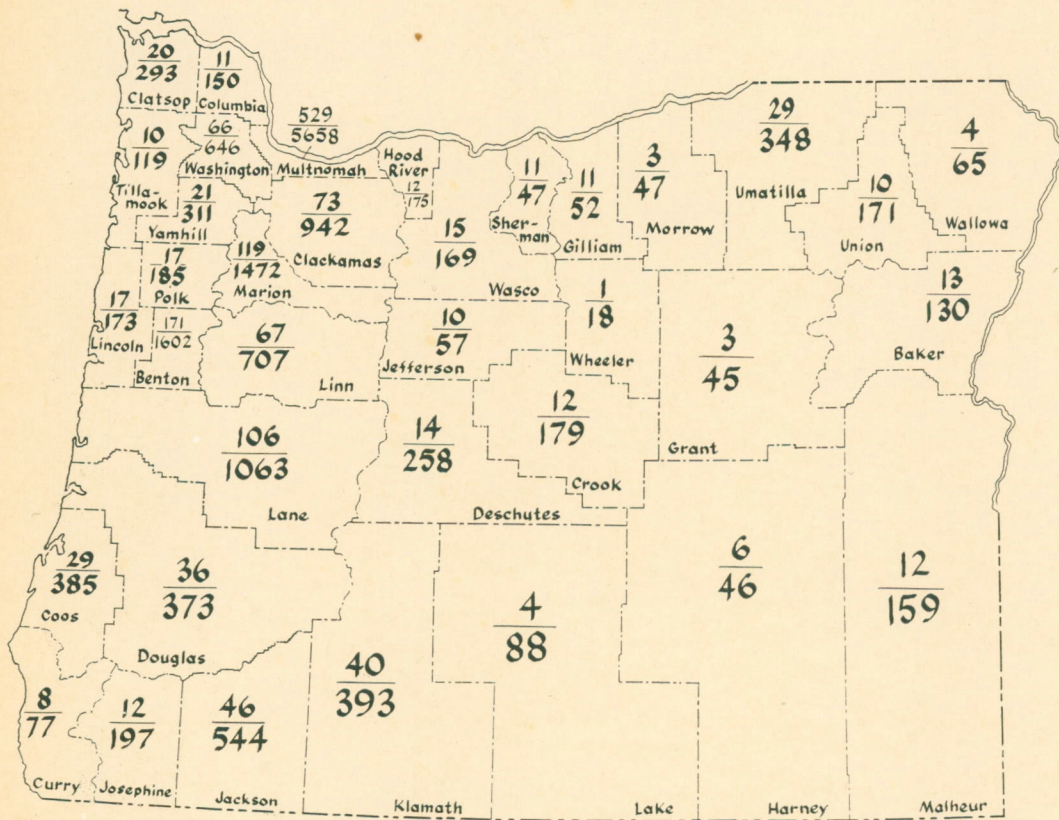

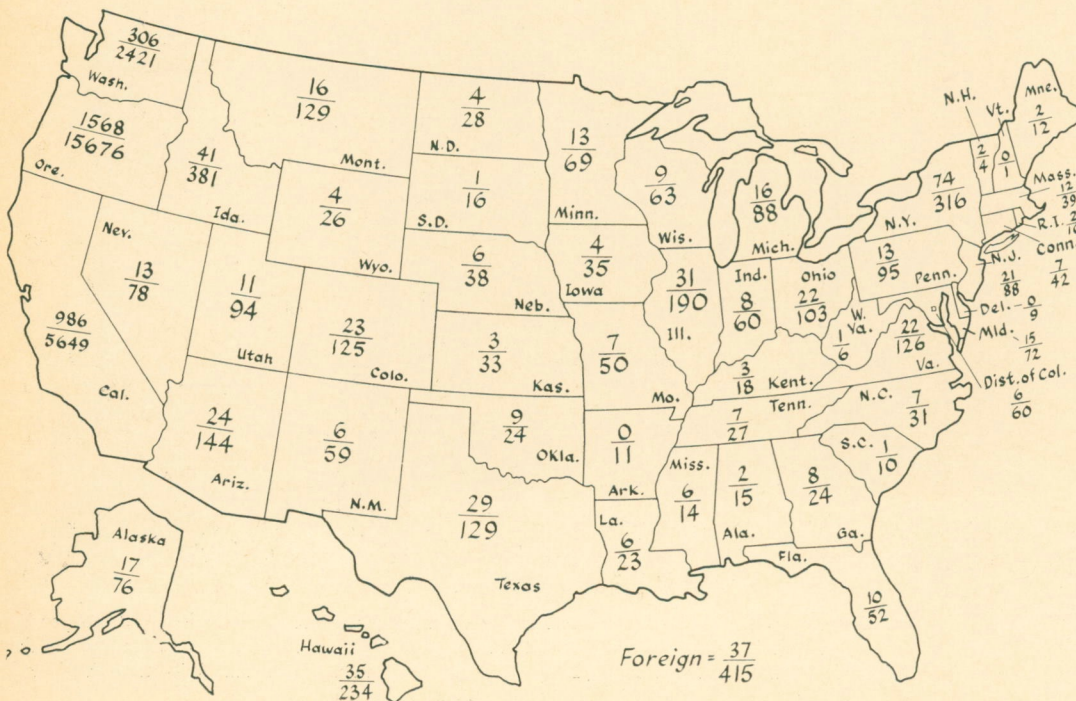

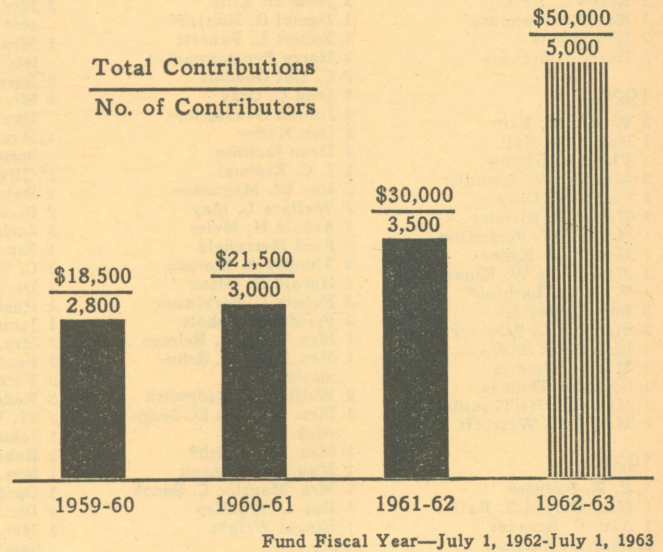

Questions and Answers

During the 1961-62 year a number of questions have been asked which may be of interest to our alumni and friends. This report will attempt to answer some of them.

1. What is object of the Association?

The Alumni Association by-laws say: "to promote the interests and ideals of Oregon State University; to stimulate and encourage loyalty in students, graduates and former students; and to develop a sense of responsibility for continued progress in educational programs of the University."

2. Who can belong?

There are three classifications: Active, Associate, and Honorary. Again the by-laws:

Active Members

"All graduates and former students, all former faculty, or current members of the academic staff of the University are eligible for active membership."

Associate Members

"Any parent of a student, former student or graduate, or any friend of the university who desires to support the activities of the Association."

Honorary Members

"Any individual who has rendered outstanding service to the University may be elected an Honorary Life Member by unanimous vote of a quorum of the Alumni Association Board of Directors."

Rights of Members

"All members shall have the right to attend the annual meeting of the Association, to have their names published in the records and receive publications of the Association. Only active members shall have the right to vote and hold office in the Association."

3. What about finances?

"There shall be a fund the purpose of which is to provide financial support for the University and the Association." (Note: The Alumni Association is financed from two main sources: (1) By funds allocated to it by the University Administration and (2) by funds received on an unrestricted basis from alumni and friends).

Contributors

"Annual contributors to the fund shall become members of the association in good standing (active member). Contributors shall become life members upon contribution of a total of \$100.00 to the fund. Those having completed payment on a life membership prior to enactment of these bylaws (July 1, 1962) are, and thereafter shall remain, life members in good standing. Those who are making payments on life membership

plans prior to enactment of these by-laws shall become, and thereafter shall remain life members in good standing upon completion of payments."

4. Board of Directors

Elective Directors of the board consist of 29 active members representing ten geographical districts; an active member representing each of the nine degree granting schools of the University; two active members representing the Golden Jubilee Association (those classes out of school 50 or more years); and the immediate Past-President of the Board.

The above points are specifically covered by the by-laws of the association. The complete by-laws will be published in the future. Copies are now available at the Alumni Office, Memorial Union 103.

Other questions:

A. I belong to the Beaver Club. How does that fit with the Alumni Association?

Payment to the Beaver Club does not qualify one for membership in the Alumni Association or apply toward a life membership.

B. What about the Oregon State Foundation and the Federation?

The Foundation is organized to administer grants, bequests from estates, and other donations that occur generally on a one-time basis. The OSU Fund is the means through which the Alumni Association receives annual contributions. Donations to either the Foundation or Fund are tax deductible. Life members in increasingly large numbers are donating to the Fund annually. Their help and encouragement is of great value and is sincerely appreciated. The Federation includes representatives of the Associated Students, the Mothers Club, the Dads Club, and the Alumni Association. It coordinates, implements, and encourages activities of various member groups in behalf of OSU.

C. How are donated funds used?

They fall into the four categories of students, faculty, institutional, and alumni. Representative items this year include: **Student:** Scholarships, loan fund, rowing club, athletics, band. **Faculty:** Outstanding teacher award, visiting professor, president's fund. **Institutional:** Hoerner Museum, Kerr Memorial Library, golf and recreation area, computer center, track and field records. **Alumni:** The bulk of expense items for operations are printing and publishing The Oregon Stater magazine and the News of Oregon State bulletin, postage, costs of handling our coded punch cards of all graduates and former students for whom

we have addresses (about 30,000), wages, office supplies and equipment, travel.

D. Is the Fund accomplishing its purpose?

Results of the past three years are encouraging. Support by alumni and friends has increased each year. This is the first year that enough unrestricted funds have been received to give to the university administration for use where the need is urgent.

E. What are those needs?

As most of you can appreciate, the budget items for operation of Oregon State must be planned as far ahead as 3½ years. This leaves many places where costs and requirements can vary. Specifically, here are some items:

- Purchase of special equipment required for teaching or research.
- Travel costs to bring prospective faculty members to the campus for interviews.
- Faculty travel costs to out of state professional meetings.
- Supplement budgets of promising researchers who may not yet be established.
- Printing of outstanding articles and papers.

HERE WE GO again with football, and what a pleasant time of year that always is. Naturally it's more pleasant when you win, but there's something about this magnetic fall sport that has an appeal for young and old, alumnus and plain fan. Football is more than just a form of athletic endeavor; the game serves as a bond for alums everywhere.

Oregon State should have a good football team this fall, certainly an interesting one. Speaking frankly, the material probably isn't as good as it was a year ago, but then again perhaps the spirit is better. Seldom in the seven years Tommy Prothro has been here have we seen OSU outclassed badly on the gridiron, and chances are it won't happen in 1962.

In case you haven't already noticed, Prothro is the only western school coach listed among the top 25 "winningest" in America at this time. His record is 46-21-2, and being a member of that select 25 means even more to a school that was mighty low just before he took over in 1955. Tommy Prothro is a winner and always will be.

What kind of a record OSU will have in 1962 is, of course, only sheer speculation. The schedule, perhaps not quite as tough as last year, nonetheless is precarious right at first. Look at those first four games—Iowa State, Iowa, Stanford and Washington. That's enough to scare anybody.

Oregon State lost a lot through graduation channels. You just don't replace men like Neil Plumley, Mike Kline, Denny Pieters,

Mike Dolby, Hank Rivera, Marne Palmateer and Norby Keolanui overnight. On the other hand, the Beavers do have a fair nucleus around which to rebuild. And best of all, there is Terry Baker.

This gifted young man from Jefferson high school of Portland already holds 14 individual all-time OSU records. Before he completes his athletic—and brilliant scholastic—record at Oregon State, the name Terry Baker will be more prominently mentioned than perhaps any athlete in the school's long and interesting history. The Terry Bakers are far and few between, so make the most of enjoying this one while he's here.

Our coaching staff wouldn't trade Terry for any college football player in America and it's easy to see why. He's a great passer, possibly the best runner on the squad and a quarterback leader seldom equalled anywhere. We've had several all-Americans at Oregon State in the past, but Baker ranks right with the best.

The backfield shows a lot of promise. Leroy Whittle has good speed at left half, and Jim Sinyard at right half can scoot when he wants to. At fullback, Bruce Williams is more the Dick Twenge type than he is a nifty dan. In other words, he likes to run over people.

The ends should be better than last year, even despite the loss of Don Kasso and Roger Johnson. Keep an eye peeled on this Vern Burke, the transfer from Bakersfield JC. He may well be the best we've had since Aaron Thomas. And such other ends as Paul Seale,

Jerry Neil, and Fred Jones can't be considered just ordinary.

True, there is a problem at tackle where we virtually were "wiped out" by graduation. But somehow, we feel that veteran Jim Funston will live up to the challenge ahead, and also Tom Holley. Perhaps others will, too, for we do need help at tackles.

George Gness and Ross Cariaga are good first-line guards. Gness may be the best left guard Prothro has ever coached since coming here. And the centers, though prone to injury in the past, have experience and savvy. We're referring to John Farrell and Dick DeBischop, a couple of truly rough customers.

Basically it amounts to this—Oregon State's 1962 football team will be one capable of beating most anyone on a given day. In no stretch of the imagination are we predicting one of those fabulous won-lost seasons, but we do know it will be one spirited, eager and well-conditioned. Sometimes that can go a long way.

As this was written, fall practice was in full swing, and several transfers were on the scene. Booker M. Washington and Olvin Moreland, both from East Los Angeles JC, had joined the squad. Obviously they can help the situation or they wouldn't be with us. Somehow, we like to let transfers prove their worth before elaborating on their merits. Both of these boys are backs, and we hear, good ones.

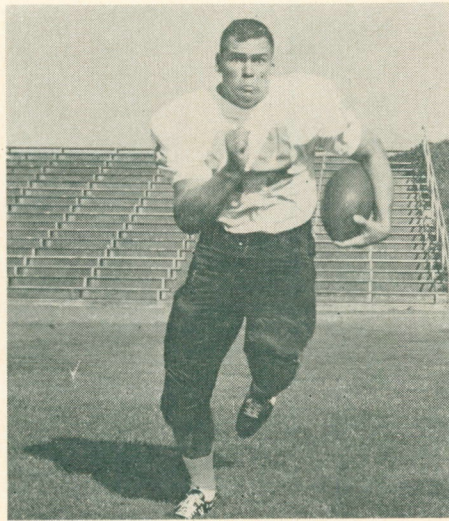
It won't be an easy fall. The season opener against Iowa State should be a dandy, what with Clay Stapleton returning with a fine

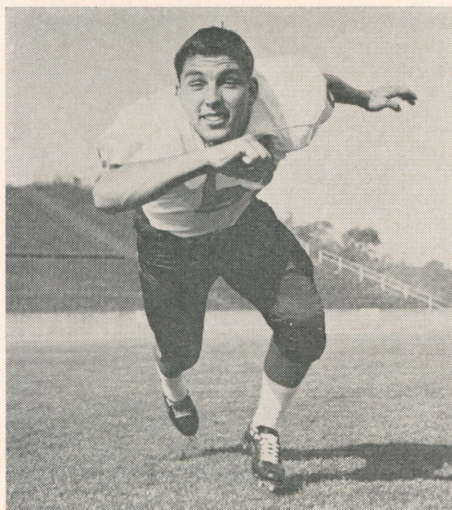

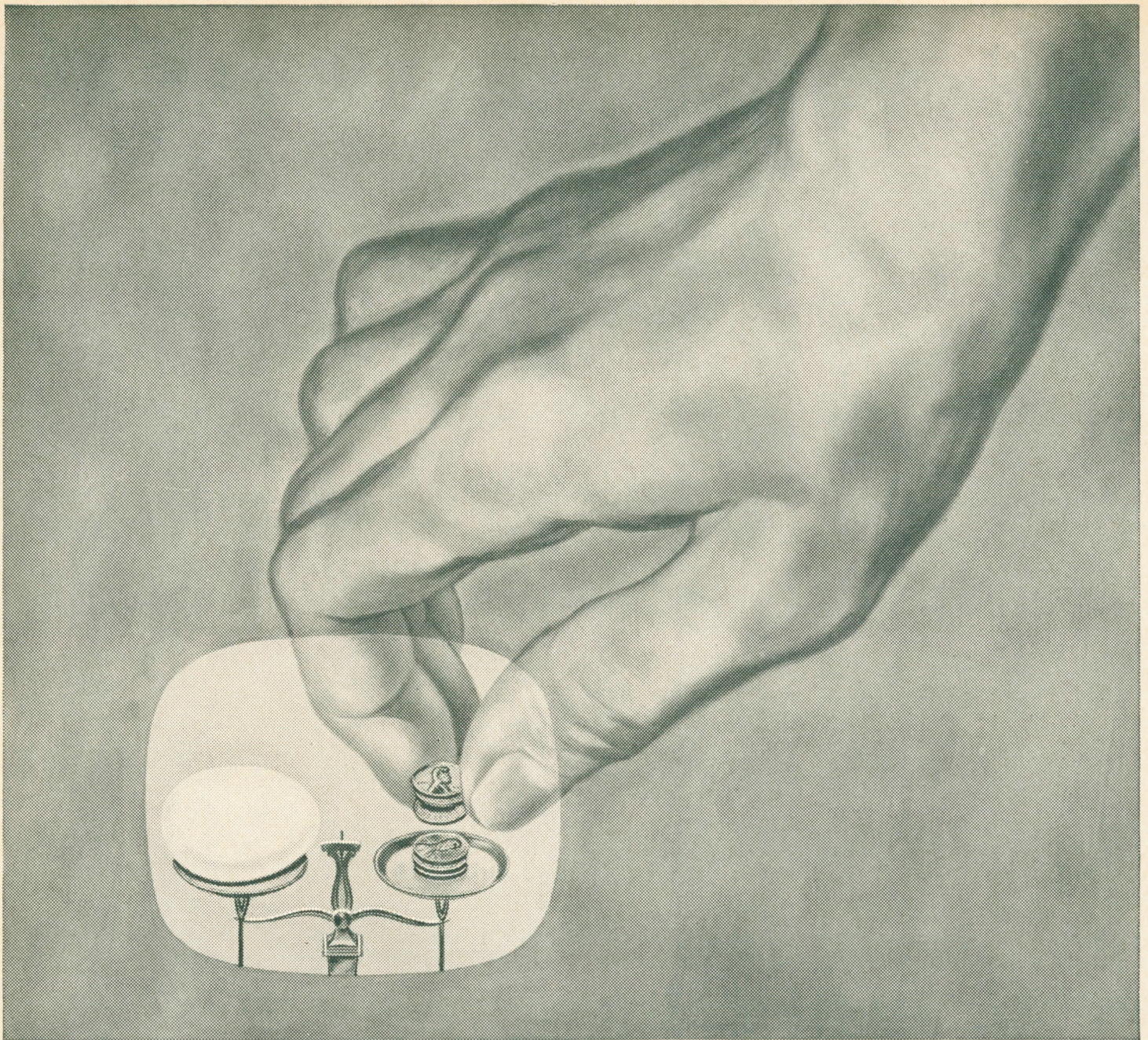
George Gness, 200 pound left guard from Novato, Calif., was elected captain of '62 Beavers.

ber 21 and the final meeting, Monday, November 26.

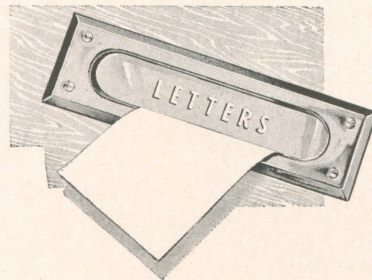
Corvallis Beaver Club
