Helped her country finish eighth overall with a 4-4 record in Macedonia in 2012, averaging 6.0 points, 6.1 rebounds and 1.1 blocks per game ... Scored 3.6 points and grabbed 3.0 rebounds per game in Hungary in 2011, helping the Germans finish ninth ... Led Germany in scoring and blocks at the 2010 U16 'B' European Championships for Women in Greece, averaging 12.4 points and 2.3 rejections.
