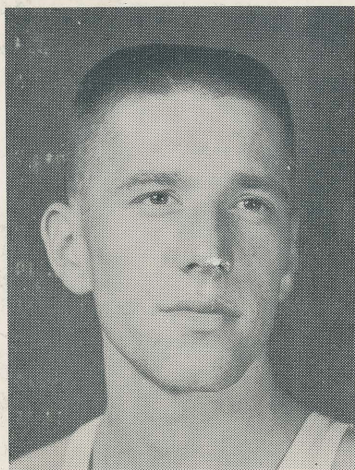

# Know Your Coaches

**RALPH COLEMAN, BASEBALL**—Native of Canby, Ore., where he attended high school. At OSU from 1914-1918, with service as lieutenant in army during World War I spaced in between. Started coaching at OSU in 1924 and has been on scene ever since, except for brief 6-year stint from 1932 through 1937 when press of other campus duties forced him to temporarily give up baseball. On P. E. staff since June of 1919 and director of summer session recreational program many years. Also was pro baseball pitcher in PCL. Now in his 32nd season of coaching baseball at OSU, has all-time record of 469-251. Led Beavers to northern division crowns in 1940, 1951, 1952, 1958 and 1962. Tied for top spot in 1938 and 1943. Went all way to NCAA regional crown in 1952.

**SAM BELL, TRACK**—Born at Columbus, Missouri, but attended high school at Giltner and Aurora in Nebraska where he was four-sports star. In navy from 1945 through 1946 and attended Doane college in Crete, Neb. where he competed in football and track. First coaching job was at Wymore, Neb. from 1950 through 1952. Was at General high of Monmouth-Independence (Oregon) next, and from 1955 through 1958 at Cottage Grove high where he developed Oregon's miler Dyrrol Burleson. Took on OSU job in spring of 1959 and led Beavers to second place finish in 1961. In 1960, Beavers ranked 4th nationally for highest finish ever.

**JIM BARRATT, GOLF**—Originally from Heppner, Ore., where he attended high school and participated in four sports. In navy in World War II, and enrolled at OSU in fall of 1946. Editor of school daily, The Barometer, in 1950, and worked a year in the alumni office before taking on the job as athletic business manager at OSU in 1951. Off and on has, been golf coach ever since.

**IRWIN HARRIS, TENNIS**—Now in his 19th season as tennis coach, with record of 127-47. Native of Corvallis and Oregon State graduate, class of 1941. Sports publicity director at OSU from 1942 to 1952 with space in between at Oregon Statesman in Salem. Director of Educational Activities at OSU since 1952. Has coached Beavers to fine record in northern division and far west competition.
