Know Your Coach

Berny Wagner, track — Starting third season as OSU track coach, following brilliant prep and college coaching career at College of San Mateo (Cal.). His teams at San Mateo won 29 of 31 dual meets. Coached 13 years in prep ranks at four California schools, following graduation from Stanford where he was an 880 runner. Attended and ran for Cal Tech in Pasadena and Stanford. Obtained A.B. degree in 1948 and M.A. degree from Stanford in 1949. Prep coaching stints were at Wheatland, Cal.; Lodi, Cal.; San Lorenzo, Cal.; and San Mateo, Cal. Prep record included 23 championships with 31 teams he coached in various divisions and at the last high school, San Mateo, won 70 of 100 cross country meets and 213 of 232 track meets. His teams at OSU have won 11 and lost 6 dual meets. In 1966, they were 4-4 and in 1967 improved to 7-2.

1968 OSU Track Sketches

ROGER CARLSEN — A Sophomore transfer from the College of San Mateo (Coach Wagner's previous school). Roger is small for a shot putter at 5-10 and 195 pounds, but has good arm speed and is exceptionally strong. His Freshman put of 53-1 $\frac{3}{4}$ leads the candidates for the 1968 Varsity.

LEW DAHLIN — The State of Oregon High School two-mile record holder until this past year with a best mark of 9:11.2. Lew showed steady progress through his Freshman and Sophomore years until felled by a broken back incurred in a fall from a mountain road while training at altitude for the 1967 NCAA Championships which were held at 4200 feet. Did not run competitively this last cross country season, but is regaining his condition. Shows excellent promise in the steeplechase.

STEVE DAVIS — An excellent all-around athlete. Has been hampered by injuries which cut down his decathlon potential. Steve has improved to 9.5 in the 100 in spite of his 6-4 and 195 pounds. He has high jumped 6-5 $\frac{1}{2}$, and is adequate in the weights. The Beaver's Number One sprinter last season.

STEVE DE AUTREMONT — A 57 ft. shot putter in high school, Steve turned to a new event, the hammer, and has progressed more in a year-and-a-half than any other athlete on record anywhere in the world. His first competition in the summer of his Freshman year in 1966 saw Steve throwing 113-8½ vs. British Columbia. Less than a year later in May of 1967, he threw 198-5 to rank as one of the top five collegiate hammer throwers in the United States. He is a Sophomore this coming season because he did not compete officially last year. He is a five year engineering student.

DICK EVANS — An excellent intermediate hurdle prospect after shaking problems due to a high school injury. Dick is Junior Class President and carries a 3.7 grade point average in industrial engineering. One of the hardest workers on a hard-working squad.

DICK FOSBURY — A favorite because of his unorthodox on-the-back style, this 6-4 Junior has cleared 7-1¼ indoors this season. Dick holds the OSU high jump record at 6-10¾, and has cleared 6-10 or better in competition 5 times.

MIKE JACKSON — A native of Southern California and the smallest man on the squad, he carries on in the tradition of "little guy-Southern Californian" Tony Albin who won the Pacific-8 long jump championship for OSU two years ago. Mike was the Beavers' leading long jumper last season until stopped by a leg injury, and is stronger than ever in pre-season drills. A student in the tough School of Pharmacy, Mike is a two-year letterman, one of the few Seniors on the squad, and one of the co-captains.

STEVE KELLY — An art major and top student. Steve briefly held the OSU high jump record at 6-10¼ last year before his teammate added a half inch later in the season. With classic jumping style and ever-increasing strength, Steve should go 7 ft. or better this season. He jumped 6-10 in practice in December, and 7-0 indoors in the AAU Championships.

JOHN LILLY — At 1:49.6 last season, he rated as the Number Two Freshman half-miler in the country. A tough competitor with good speed, John can run both the 880 and the mile. His best event is still to be determined.

JIM LOCKARD — Two years ago Jim was the third fastest intermediate hurdler in Freshman ranks in the country. He improved during his Sophomore year in spite of minor injury problems, and should have an excellent Junior season.

GREG MARKS — Can run 100, 220, 440, and both relays. Should develop this season as a top quartermiler. Progress has been slowed by an injury incurred in the state high school meet in his Senior year. Now ready to take over for departed team captain and Pacific-8 record holder, Steve Pancoast.

GEORGE MAY — An All-American in the long jump as a Sophomore, George was fourth in the NCAA meet in 1967 and rates Number Two in the all-time OSU long jump list. Also a fine triple jumper, he will do double duty and lead the Beavers in these events.

BOB MAYES — The utility man for the track squad, just as he was for the football team where he was backup quarterback, kick-off return man, and wingback. Bob has improved from a 10.2 high school sprinter to 9.7 (9.6w). Runs the 100, 220, 440, high and intermediate hurdles, and on both relay teams if called upon. The regular Number Three man on what looks to be a fine 440 relay team this season.

FRED MILTON — A 62 ft. shot putter in high school, Fred put the 16 pound ball 52-1 last season while dividing his time with spring football practice. This year he will concentrate strictly on track. Has good potential in the discus, also.

CHARLIE OLDS — Charlie jumped 24-6 $\frac{1}{4}$ and 48-8 $\frac{3}{4}$ last season after a year's lay-off from track. A fine competitor, a two year starting defensive halfback for the Beaver football team, one of three fine horizontal jumpers.

DON PARISH — California State high school high hurdles champion in 1966. A transfer from Los Angeles City College, now in his Sophomore year. Don has 9-8 speed and is big (6-4, 190 pounds). He has all the equipment to be one of the top high hurdlers in the country.

ROD PAUL — British Columbia Junior Athlete of the Year for his exploits on the Rook track squad last season. Rod broke the OSU 440 Freshman record with a time of 48.0. The former record was held by Steve Pancoast who is now co-holder of the Pacific-8 440 record. Rod's speed has improved to 9.8 and fall workouts have shown that he has gained a great deal of strength.

STEVE PENSINGER — A Sophomore transfer from Foothill College in Los Altos Hills, California. Steve was third in the State Junior College meet intermediate hurdles, and is also a fine high hurdler. He adds depth to the latter event.

DENNIS PHILLIPS — One of the top five vaulters in the world. Dennis has been over 17 ft. three times. After spending a year at the College of San Mateo under Coach Wagner's tutelage, he followed his coach north to re-join him. One of the few Seniors on the squad, he has been vaulting well in practice during the fall months in OSU's fine indoor vaulting facility. Is national indoor champion.

JOHN RADETICH — The youngest of OSU's high jumping triumvirate, John, a Sophomore, has cleared "only 6-9 $\frac{3}{4}$ ", but he has done this four times. Could be a 7 ft. jumper this spring.

TERRY SCHUKART — A half miler-miler, Terry could solve a lot of problems for the 1968 Beavers by continuing to bring down his mile time. A fine competitor, he has had his best races when they were needed most.

ERNIE SMITH — A Sophomore in eligibility due to a knee injury last season, Ernie was the Rook record holder in both sprints until his records were lowered last season. Now stronger and running better than ever, Ernie looks forward to an excellent year. Multi-world record holder Tommie Smith, is Ernie's older brother.

CRAIG SONNIKSEN — Having manned the hurdles for OSU single-handedly for two years, Craig has help from two transfers this coming season. A B+ student and a two-year letterman, he should have his best year ever. Is co-captain of squad.

ROGER STALICK — After throwing over 230 feet last season as a Sophomore, Roger injured a knee on a loose runway and was not able to compete further. A knee operation last summer and another one in December for this injury makes his progress a question mark. It is hoped that he will throw this season.

TERRY THOMPSON — A commercial fisherman in the summers, who grosses over \$10,000 each year, Terry is one of the top half-milers in the United States. A fierce competitor, he hates to lose even in an untimed practice run. After a summer of fishing and an appendectomy, he came back stronger than ever in cross country and is one of four OSU track men who have a solid chance at being at the Olympic Games in Mexico City next October.

WILLIE TURNER — One of the world's outstanding sprinters. As a Freshman, Willie was second in the Pan American Games 100 meters (after defeating his conqueror at the same distance in two previous encounters). Anchored the USA 440 relay team in the European tour. Unofficially tied the world record at 100 meters, and ran the second fastest 220 in history. Willie's starting problems should be helped with this winter's indoor races and through continued work. There is no limit to Willie's potential. Tied world indoor mark in 50 yds. in January.

TIM VOLLMER — OSU record holder in the discus as a Sophomore, Tim is 15 pounds heavier, stronger, and has thrown 20 ft. farther in practice this winter than last year. He is a fine student of this event.

TIM VOTH — Number Three Freshman in the Nation's javelin throwers last season. Tim has completed a 6 months military obligation and returned to school winter term. He should have a fine Sophomore year.

1967 OSU Dual Meet Record
