

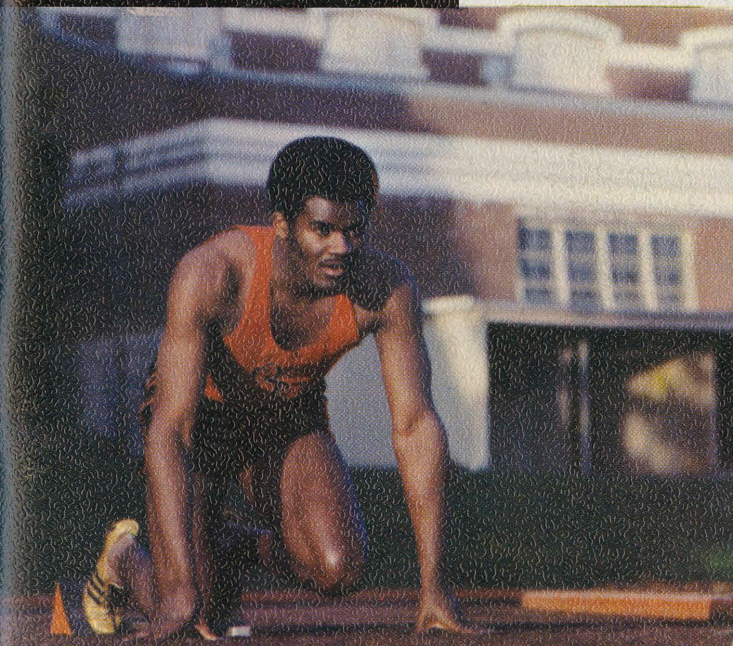
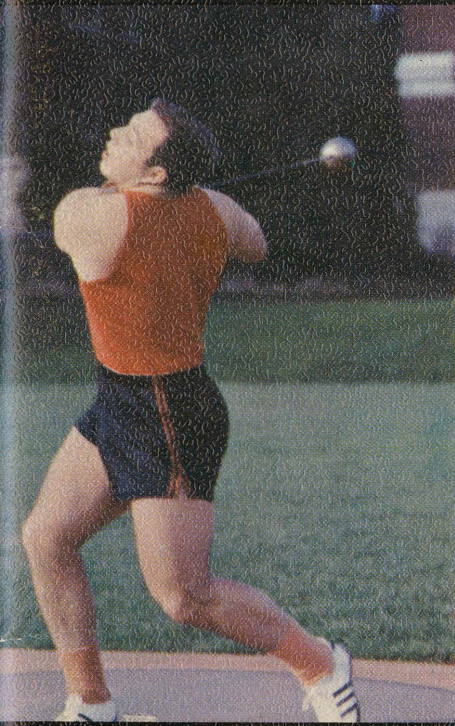

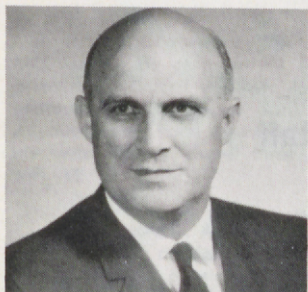

Know Your Coaches . . .

BERNY WAGNER, Head Track Coach — starting his fifth year as Oregon State's track coach, Wagner is anticipating another successful season. Last year the Beavers finished third in the nation for the highest finish ever by an Oregon State track team. OSU had three individual national champions, the greatest number of any school in the country. Two of these champions, Jim Barkley in the steeplechase and Steve DeAutremont in the hammer throw, will be back. One reason for optimism is the fact that in every event, with the exception of the intermediate hurdles, there are one or two men on the 1970 squad who rank in the top five of all time at Oregon State.

Since coming to Oregon State following a brilliant prep and junior college coaching career, Wagner's teams have won 23 of 31 dual meets. After failing to score with his first team at the 1966 NCAA meet, his teams have progressively moved toward the top. In 1967, Oregon State was thirteenth in the Nation with 16 points. In 1968, the Beavers moved up to sixth with 26 points, and last year they tied for third with an all-time OSU high of 40 points. During these three years, seven Beavers have been named to the NCAA All-American track team in seven different events.

Wagner coached thirteen years in prep ranks at four California high schools following graduation from Stanford where he was an 880 runner. He obtained his AB degree in 1948, and his MA degree from Stanford in 1949. He moved to Oregon State after three years at the College of San Mateo where his teams won 29 of 31 dual meets and two conference championships. Wagner, and his wife, Nancy, have three children, Erica, 21, Carl, 18, and Jeff, 12.

CHUCK McNEIL, Assistant Coach — McNeil, who joined the OSU staff in 1965, divides his time between track duties and teaching judo and other physical education classes at Oregon State. He is a 1959 graduate of San Jose State and former assistant track coach at Bakersfield College (1960-61) and head coach at South High School in Bakersfield (1962-64). A graduate of Turlock High in 1951, McNeil spent four years in the Navy before entering Modesto Junior College and later San Jose. During his senior year at San Jose, he was a member of the world's fastest 880 relay team. He competed collegiately in the sprints and 440.

In 1965, McNeil joined the OSU staff while completing work on his Master's degree in education.

ROY BURNS, Assistant Coach — Newly hired assistant coach, Roy Burns, is a graduate of Eastern Washington College and has fourteen years of coaching experience in Oregon and Washington. During that time he compiled a record of seven league championships in track. Last spring he missed the magic mark of 100 by having a career coaching total of 99 victories. The past five years he has been the head track coach at Hudson's Bay High School in Vancouver, Washington, where his teams have never lost a dual or home meet. He was elected Coach of the Year by the Vancouver Coaches Association at the end of last season. He is married, has four children and is working on a Master's degree in guidance and counseling.

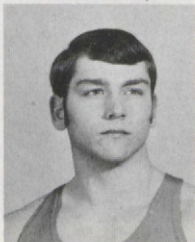
1970 OSU Track Sketches

STEVE ATHAY — Was the leader of the three longest throwing rook discus throwers in OSU history. Steve holds the rook record and shows great promise along with sophomore teammates Bob Thomas and Roger Smith, to furnish strength in this event, although two-time All-America Tim Vollmer has graduated.

JOE BAISCH — Transferred from Seattle's Highline College two years ago, now adjusted to the competition of the Pacific-8. Did not run cross country due to illness but rounding into condition.

JIM BARKLEY — Improved from 9:48 in the two-mile as a high school senior to 4:06.4, 8:54.2, and a national championship in the steeplechase in the second best time ever run in the NCAA meet, 8:44.4. All in his sophomore year. Jim has been battling knee injury incurred in the NCAA meet, and did not run cross country this past fall.

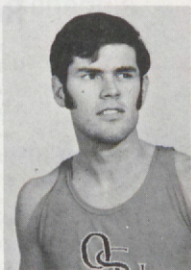

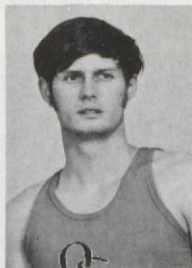
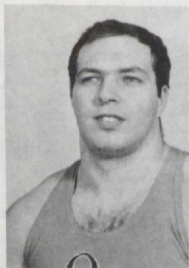
DOUG CROOKS — The third fastest high school miler in the United States last year. Doug is an excellent prospect, has had mononucleosis through the winter, and has just resumed training.

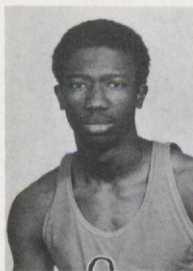

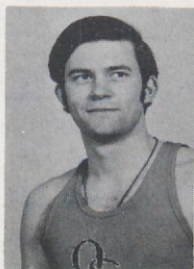

SPENCER LYMAN — A fine local long distance prospect, Spencer is ready to improve on his 8:54 time of last year. Could be a big surprise in major competition.

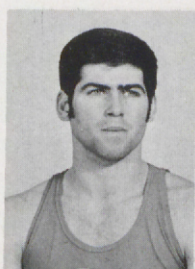
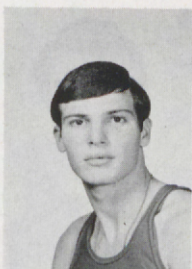
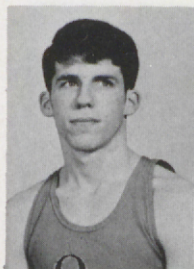
GEORGE MAY — An NCAA All-American in his sophomore year, George sat out last season with an injury to his arm. He furnishes strength in both the long jump and triple jump.

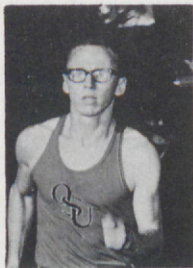
STEVE NORRIS — Senior vaulter from Milwaukie, will furnish great depth in his event.

TRACY SMITH — National AAU three-mile champion, Tracy has completed two years in the Army and has one more season at Oregon State. Will lead an ever improving distance corps.

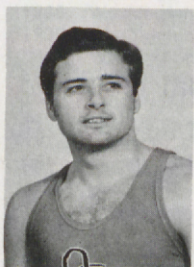
WILLIE TURNER — One of the fine sprinters in the United States. Willie, who has held shares of world records in the 100 meters and 50 yard dash, also has the second fastest 220 ever run at 20.2. He should have a fine senior season. Stronger than ever and free of the injuries which knocked him out of the final Olympic Trials after he qualified for the semi-finals in the 100 meters, Willie has his eye on National Championships.

TIM VOTH — Improved from 224' to 239' last season, seems destined to further improvement this season, using a new training system.

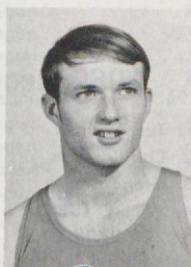
DENIS WALP — Transferred from Fullerton College two years ago, improved to 16' last year, seems to have whipped the injury jinx which has hampered his career.

GERRY WHITTAKER — Gerry returned to track last season after concentrating on spring football in the season of 1968.
