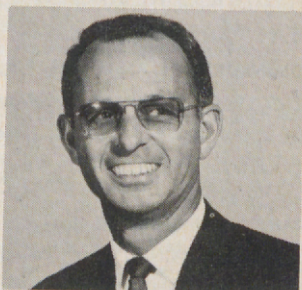

Know Your Coaches

BERNY WAGNER, Head Track Coach — Starting his sixth year as Oregon State's track coach, Wagner is anticipating another successful season. In the past three years the Beavers have been sixth, third, and fifth in the nation, bringing Wagner's teams into the small circle of the track elite. Only five other schools, Villanova, Brigham Young, USC, UCLA, and WSU have been in the top ten for the past three years. After two "building" years as the new track program at Oregon State got under way, the dual meet record in the past three years has been seventeen wins out of twenty-two meets. Two of the five losses were by a single point to National powers University of Texas at El Paso, and UCLA.

Wagner and his Assistant Coaches have produced more individual national championships the past three years at OSU than have been produced at any other institution in the United States. Add to this an Olympic champion and numerous conference champions, and it can be seen that the trademark of Oregon State's track program is achievement of excellence.

Wagner coached thirteen years in prep ranks at four California high schools following graduation from Stanford, where he was a half-miler. He obtained his A.B. degree in 1948, and his M.A. degree from Stanford in 1949. He moved to Oregon State after three years at the College of San Mateo where his teams won 29 of 31 dual meets and two conference championships. Wagner and his wife Nancy have three children.

CHUCK McNEAL, Assistant Coach — McNeil, who joined the OSU staff in 1965, divides his time between track duties and teaching judo and other physical education classes at Oregon State. He works primarily with Oregon State's very successful sprinters. His most outstanding runner is national champion Willie Turner.

McNeil is a 1959 graduate from San Jose State, a former assistant track coach at Bakersfield College (1960-61) and head coach at South High in Bakersfield (1962-64). A graduate of Turlock High in 1951, McNeil spent four years in the Navy before entering Modesto Junior College and later San Jose State. During his senior year at San Jose, he was a member of the world's fastest 880 relay team.

NEIL WEBBER, Assistant Coach — Is a graduate of Milwaukie High School and received Bachelors and Masters Degrees from Lewis and Clark College in 1964 and 1969. He was Northwest Conference 880 Champion in 1961, and ran for the Oregon Track Club in 1965 and the Santa Monica Athletic Club under famed Hungarian Coach Mihai Igloi in 1967. Neil is single, and has been cross country and track coach at Fort Vancouver High School in Vancouver, Washington for the past three years.

STEVE DeAUTREMONT, Assistant Coach — Although graduated last June, Steve is doing two years of graduate work at Oregon State University. He is heading up the weight training of the track squad plus coaching hammer throwers and other weight men. DeAutremont is from Eugene, where he was an all-state football player and track man at St. Francis High School. He devoted his full time to the discus and hammer throw for two years at Oregon State and then concentrated only on the hammer becoming the National collegiate champion in both 1969 and 1970 with the best throw of 207-2. He made the USA team which toured Europe and Russia and is looking forward to Olympic competition in the future. His wife Mary Lee has also graduated from Oregon State and is teaching in Corvallis.

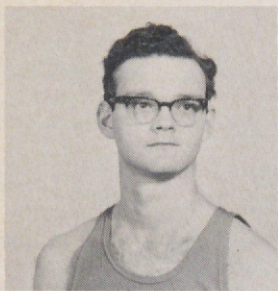

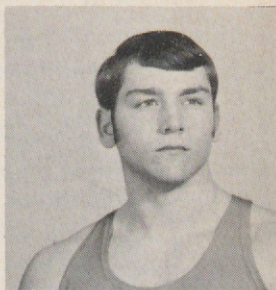

HAROLD AGNER **Junior** **5-10** **132** **21**

Agner, a pre-med student, has a 3.00 gpa and is from Centennial High of Gresham. He was two time high school state champion and record holder in the 440 with a best of 48.0. Has been plagued with injuries through high school and college and had to forgo his sophomore year of competition completely. His best marks of 47.6 and 47.2 in a mile relay leg are really just a beginning.

STEVE ATHAY **Junior** **6-3** **227** **20**

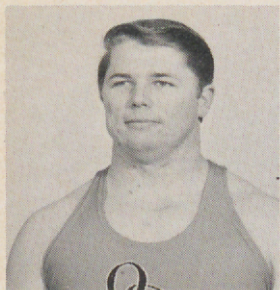
Also a pre-med major, Athay holds the OSU rook record in the discus and has a gpa of 3.50. A graduate of Ft. Vancouver High, Athay threw 167-7 as a freshman in setting the record and in doing so had to beat three of the top ten high school discus throwers in the nation of the year before, all of whom enrolled at OSU. Dedication to technique and to heavy weight lifting have been the key to Athay's increase in size from 190 to 227 pounds, and to his success. His wife Vickie is also from Vancouver, WA.

RON BORDEN **Junior** **6-3½** **160** **20**

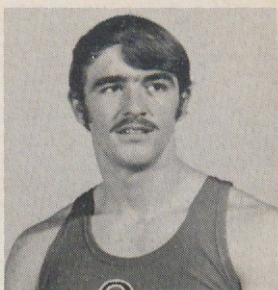
A native of Corvallis, Borden ran a 1:51.9 for his top half mile effort as a sophomore last year. His best high school time was 1:55.8. He is a sociology major.

CHRIS CAREY **Sophomore** **5-11** **145** **19**

A sophomore in science education, Carey was born in San Francisco, but now lives in San Carlos. He attended Carlmont High where he ran a 9:12 two mile. He is the holder of three OSU Rook records, 9:06.2 in the two mile, 14:15.6 in the three mile and 9:17.6 in the steeplechase. Has been troubled by mononucleosis and flu during his high school and freshman career. If healthy, could develop into a very outstanding distance ace, according to his coach.

ROGER CARLSON Senior 5-10 230 23

A graduate of Mills High in northern California, Carlson is small as top caliber shot putters go, but he makes up his lack of size with quickness and exceptional strength. He has bench pressed 430 pounds and handles 540 pounds in the squat. At the Oregon Indoor meet in January, he set a new OSU Indoor record and his all-time best with a toss of 59-0. He is shooting at Lahcen Samsam's school record of 60-2 $\frac{1}{4}$.

STEPHEN CASEY Freshman 6-0 156 19

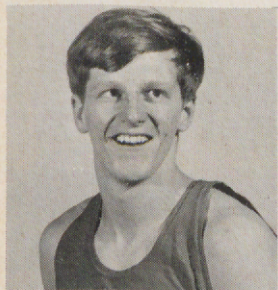
Even though in his first year, Casey will probably be the Beaver's top intermediate hurdler with the loss of Tom Ries, due to a foot injury that has not responded to medical treatment. Casey is from Peterborough, Australia. He was an all-around athlete at Rostrevor College in Adelaide, South Australia and chose OSU because of the fine school of agriculture and track program. He is an agricultural economics major. Australian Olympic hurdler Gary Knoke recommended OSU to Casey. His best high school time was 53.7.

NEIL ERICKSON Junior 6-2 175 20

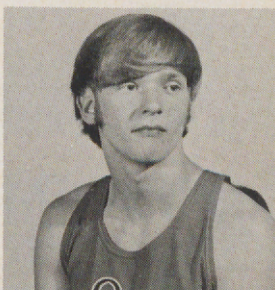
A Jackson High graduate in Portland, Erickson is one of many high jumpers to switch to the Fosbury Flop method. He had a season-opening jump of 6-10 last year and could easily hit the seven foot mark this season. He has made the jumping style switch with the help of Dick Fosbury, who is still in school at OSU. Erickson's high school coach was Butch Lumby, former OSU sprint champion.

MIKE FLEER Freshman 6-6 184 18

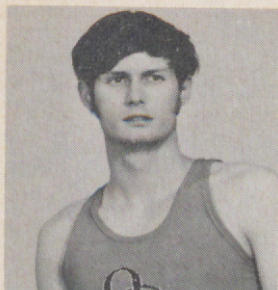
A graduate of McNary High in Salem, Fleer won the high school meet last year with a record 6-9 leap. According to his coach, Fleer has the height and spring to become a great high jumper. He used the straddle roll through high school but was so encouraged by John Radetich's change to the Flop that he too switched to the new style this year. Prefers the long jump and also runs on the Beaver 440 relay team. Had a pre-season jump of 24-5, then injured an ankle in a physical education class and will not compete this spring. Was elected by teammates to be co-captain for the 1971 season.

RICK GOLDNER Junior 6-1 140 20

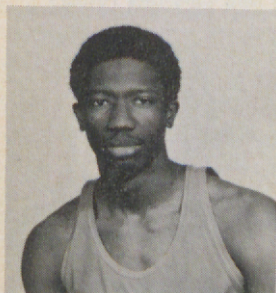

LEON JOHNSON Senior 6-0 145 22

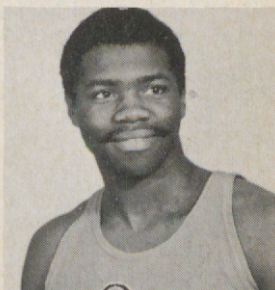

LOWELL HARRIS Junior 6-3 200 20

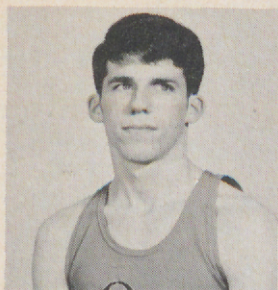

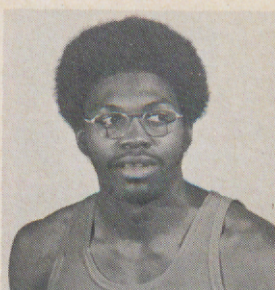

SPENCER LYMAN 5-8 135 Senior 21

Born in Bar Harbor, Maine, Lyman came to Corvallis from McGrath, Alaska. He graduated from Corvallis High, where he had a 4:20.3 mile and 9:18.8 two-mile. Concentrating on the two-mile, he has run 8:47.4 and is the OSU cross country course record holder, running the four-mile distance in better times than Olympians Tracy Smith, Gerry Lindgren and Ken Moore, 19:25.4.

ROBERT MEDLOCK Senior 5-9 160 21

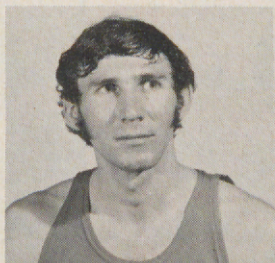
Medlock, a marketing major in the school of Business and Technology originally attended Abilene Christian College in Abilene, Texas. Because he wanted to run in the PAC-8, he transferred to OSU after his sophomore year. He then sat out his transfer year and lost a year of eligibility in order to make the transfer. While at AC, he was sixth in the National USTFF 100 dash championships and had a best time of 9.5, although he ran several wind-aided 9.4 races. Last year, while running unattached, he again ran a 9.5 race. Because he has an extremely fast start out of the blocks, Medlock is a fine 60 yard dash prospect.

DAVID MELVILLE Freshman 6-2 184 18

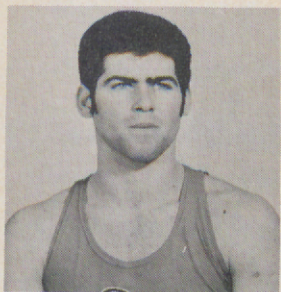

KEITH MUNSON Junior 6-0 150 24

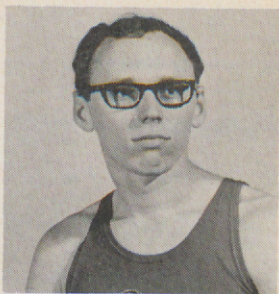
A graduate of Ashland High, Munson won the AA high school two-mile title in 1965. His best time was 9:19.2. In two years at OSU, he brought his mile time down 15 seconds to 4:11.0. He also ran a 9:01 mile and 14:02 three mile. He then entered the Army for three years, including a year and half in Vietnam. Munson placed sixth in the NCAA cross country championships last fall. ROD PAUL Senior 6-1 172 22

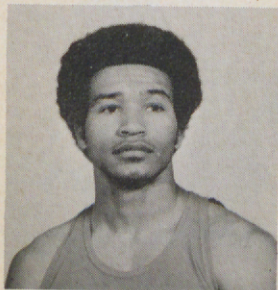

ROBERT READER Senior 6-0 175 21

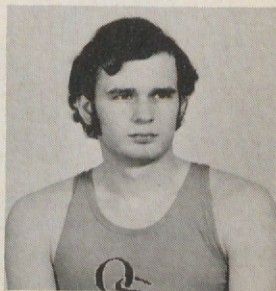

GREG RIGBY Junior 6-1 190 21

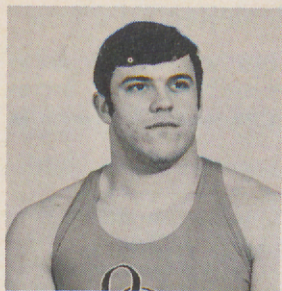

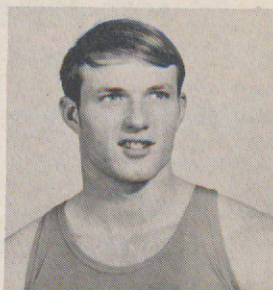
