Know Your Coaches

OSU HEAD TRACK COACH BERNY WAGNER

Now in his eighth season, Wagner joined the OSU staff in 1965, following outstanding prep and college coaching careers in California. He has made OSU a contender on the National track and field scene. During a three year period, OSU finished sixth, third and fifth in NCAA competition. Since Wagner took over at OSU, the Beavers have had 12 individuals win 18 All-American honors and 7 National championships. OSU men have taken more individual National collegiate championships in the past five years than have athletes at any other school. Willie Turner, Dick Fosbury, Jim Barkley, Steve DeAutremont, and Tom Woods have captured seven National titles.

The Beaver's dual meet record since Wagner joined the staff has been 41 wins in 57 dual meet contests. Never has he had a losing season at OSU. Eleven current members of the OSU track team were listed among the top 50 in the National and world-wide rankings at the end of 1972.

Wagner coached thirteen years in prep ranks at four California schools following graduation from Stanford, where he was a half-miler. He obtained his A.B. degree in 1948, and a year later his M.A. degree from Stanford. He moved to OSU after three years at College of San Mateo, where his teams won 29 of 31 dual meets and two conference championships. His first coaching job (1949-51) was at Wheatland, California, where he taught and coached all sports. He was basketball, cross country, and track coach at Lodi for three years and basketball and track coach at San Lorenzo for two years. In 1955 he became department head of boys' P.E. at San Mateo High, also coaching track and cross country. In 1962 he moved to College of San Mateo.

Wagner is a current member of the NCAA track and field rules committee and has held membership on the executive committee of the United States Cross Country Coaches Association and the Naionalt AAU Mens' Track and Field Committee. He was a visiting lecturer for the Mexican government in preparation of coaches and officials prior to the 1968 Olympics.

Wagner's list of publications includes articles on the High Jump,

Wagner's list of publications includes articles on the High Jump, "Fosbury Flop" method of high jumping, Simple Isometrics, and Starting Techniques. He was a featured lecturer at the 1973 International Coaches Association Congress in Madrid, Spain.

A native of Fresno, California, Wagner attended high school in

A native of Fresno, California, Wagner attended high school in Sacramento and Palo Alto before entering Stanford. His college career was interrupted when he joined the Navy V-12 program in 1942. He was discharged in 1946 after seeing action in the Pacific and Japanese theaters. He and his wife Nancy have three children.

CHUCK McNEIL, Assistant Coach - McNeil, who originally joined the OSU Track staff in 1965, returns this season after spending a year on leave. He had a Fulbright Professorship to the University of Dar es Salaam, in Tanzania, and also served as a sports specialist to Uganda and Ghana part of the time. He will work mainly with Oregon State sprinters. One of his best known proteges was Willie Turner, NCAA 220 champion. McNeil is a 1959 graduate of San Jose State and received his master's degree in health and counseling and guidance from OSU in 1965. He served as assistant track coach at Bakersfield College (1960-61) and was head coach at South High in Bakersfield (1962-64). A graduate of Turlock High in 1951, McNeil spent three years in the Navy before entering Modesto Junior College and later San Jose State, where he was a member of the world's fastest 880 relay team his senior year. In addition to this track coaching duties, McNeil is an assistant professor of physical education at Oregon State. Born: 9-25-33. Wife: Beverly.

DAN ACKER, Assistant Coach — A former prep star at West Linn High School, graduating in 1967, Dan Acker, 29, handles OSU's long jumpers and triple jumpers while working on a master's degree in education. A former prep state high jump champion, Acker, 29, graduated from Lewis and Clark College in 1967. He held Northwest Conference high jump mark and participated three years in the NAIA nationals. In 1969 he entered the Army and helped coach Arnie Robinson among others at Ft. McArthur.

DENNIS PHILLIPS, Assistant Coach — Oregon State's pole vault coach is Dennis Phillips, former OSU star, national junior college record holder while at San Mateo Junior College and national indoor record holder at 17-34 in 1969. Phillips, 26, graduated from OSU in 1970 after following coach Wagner to OSU out of junior college. Last year he was an Olympic trials finalist and has a best of 17-1 to his credit. He is married.

TIM VOLLMER, Assistant Coach — Tim Vollmer, 26, is a former Oregon high school discus throw champion from Benson High in Portland. He is the school record holder at 204-2, placed eighth at the Summer Olympics in 1972 and was the top ranked discus thrower for 1973 in the nation at 218-5. He has the third best discus throw in the world at 221-1 (1971) and is finishing his studies after a two-year stint in the Army.

ROBBIN ROEDER, Assistant Coach — was number two on OSU's all-time list, with a best of 163-8 in the hammer throw. Roeder, 25, won the Canadian National title in 1971 with a 191-8 throw. He and his wife Judy, who is daughter of his Canadian coach, live in Cotvallis.

LEN McLAUGHLIN, Assistant Coach — OSU's javelin and shot put coach is Len McLaughlin, 33, a graduate of St. Cloud State College. He coached nine years at Anoka High School and also worked with junior college athletes in the area. He was district department chairman of health and physical education while employed by the Anoka school district. McLaughlin, who also attended the University of Minnesota for wo years, is married and the father of three young boys.

In 1971 he had the fastest 2 M and 3 M marks in the country for prep juniors. Ran 4:09.5 mile senior year and ran 4:12.4 in the Golden West Invitational, equaling the winners time. Also won the Chicago All-Star Invitational. Concentrated on the shorter distances as a senior to help speed. College Career: Ran cross country last fall, was sixth in Northern Division meet, established OSU Rook and course record for freshman and finished 58th in NCAA championships, the fourth best freshman in the meet.

ONIA BATES 5-11 160 Senior 22 Sprints



RANDY BROWN 5-101/2 125 Freshman 18 Distances Prep Career: An outstanding academic student and athlete, Brown graduated from Sunset High of Beaverton in 1972. He had a 3.33 gpa, won the Oregon class AAA cross country title in 1971 and last year captured the class AAA 2M championship. Has a 9:13.2 best. He also won title in Oregon AAU cross country meet and Seaside Run for high school students. College Career: Won a spot on OSU's young cross country team last fall and placed 12th in the Northern Division meet and was a member of OSU's team in the NCAA championships that placed 16th. Won one corss country meet, finishing first at Arcata, California. He improved his 2M time to 9:01.5 in the Oregon Indoor Invitational in January.

DOUG CRAMER 6-2 235 Junior 20 Ham.-Disc.-Shot



Should help improve OSU's sprinting corp and through early spring, was leading sprinter.

Prep Career: Ranked nationally with a 228-5 javelin throw as a prep at Central Linn High, graduating in 1970. Also threw shot, 46-8, and discus, 130. Played basketball and football. Played offensive and defensive end, centered the ball on punts and PAT attempts and kicked off. College Career: Worked on weights and technique first year at OSU. Has a best of 232-2. Had arm trouble last year, finished with a 230-2 best. Scored 26 team points, 12th best on team.

Attended Grant High as a freshman, then finished final three years at Adams. As a freshman, third in State 220. Following year second in 220 and third in 100. As a junior, he won both events, then repeated feat in 1970. Scored $22\,V_2$ team points in both State meets, also anchoring winning 440 relay teams. He holds City record in 220 and is co-holder of City and Regional record in 100. Finished third at National Junior Olympics in Colorado in 1971 in 100 dash. Coached by Larry Delaney. **College Career:** Is seeing first varsity action this spring, will be counted on in both sprints and 440 relay.

HAILU EBBA 5-9 140 Junior 21 Middle Distance

Prep Career: From Addis, Ethiopia, graduating from Anderson High in Anderson, California in 1970. He is working on a medical degree at OSU. Credentials in mile as prep were not outstanding. Had 4:43.2 best. However, 49.2 in 440 and 2:03 in 880, indicating speed. Attended high school in California as an exchange student before enrolling in OSU. College Record: Made almost unbelievable progress first year, improving to 4:05.2 in mile. A determined athlete, Hailu wanted to represent his country in the 1972 Olympics. He did so after a fine sophomore season, winning his first Olympic trial heat in Munich. Did not place, however, in the semi-finals. He holds the Rook record in the 880, 1:49.7, and mile 4:05.2. Led team in scoring last year with 49½ points. Ran 1500 meters in 3:40.4, sixth best collegiate time in country last year, and was fifth in mile at 3:59.3, second OSU runner to break 4:00.0. Has done 880 in 1:48.9. Won Pacific-8 mile in 1972 in 4:03.2. Set new OSU indoor marks this year in 1500 meters (3:46.4 at Madison Square Garden) and mile (4:02.2 in Astrodome).

BOB GLAZE 5-6 168 Senior 21 Sprints-Long Jump

Prep Career: An outstanding swimmer as well as track performer from Mercer Island, Washington. A 1969 graduate, placed three years in state meet in butterfly. Won three letters in track in State long jump. As a senior, was Outstanding Athlete at Mercer Island High. First to ever win four letters in different sports at Mercer Island, cross country, track, football and swimming. College Career: Claims to be fastest sprinter in country under 5-7. A very hard worker, he worked his way onto the squad as a freshman and sophomore, beating out others with more talent. Scored 15½ team points as a sophomore, 23½ last year. Has done 9.7 and 21.8 although did not equal those marks last year. Holds the Rook long jump mark of 24-1½. Elected co-captain for the 1973 season.

Prep Career: Graduated from Phoenix (Oregon) High in 1970. He is a former two-time State class AA 2M champion and was 11th in State as sophomore. Also placed 16th, second and first in class AA cross country meets in three consecutive years. College Career: Had a fine freshman season, set Rook records in 6M (30:34) and steeplechase (8:55.4. The latter has developed into "his" event. Scored nine team points as a freshman, added 38 last year. Improved his steeple time to 8:46.8 in NCAA trials last summer, 12th best among collegians in 1972. Has 2M best of 8:53.2, 3M of 13:43.3 and 6M of 30.34.0, quite an improvement from his prep bests of 4:28.1 and 9:30.4 for 1M and 2M. On OSU's all-time chart, ranks third in 2M and 3M second in steeplechase.

SCOTT JACKSON 6-1 145 Sophomore 19 Distances
Prep Career: Won two class AAA cross country titles while at
Grant High of Portland. Coached by Mark Cotton. Led Grant to
two state titles. Prep bests were 2:00.0 in 880, 4:15.7 in 1M and
9:23 in 2M. College Career: Last year established new Rook record
of 9:01.2 in 2M. Ranks third at OSU with 9:00.2 steeplechase, 32nd
best collegiately in 1972. Finished 13th at Northern Division cross
country meet last fall.

Prep Career: Attended Marshall High in Portland, graduating in 1969. Cleared 15 feet in high school and senior year won first at national junior championships meet. College Career: As a freshman, established a Rook record of 15-6 outdoors and also did 16-0 indoors. Did not compete in 1971 and last year competed for the Staters Track Club. Last summer he topped 17-2 at an all-comers meet in Eugene, the second Beaver pole vaulter in recent years to clear 17 feet. Will be number one this year.

CLAY LOWREY 6-2 153 Senior 22 880

Prep Career: A prep standout at El Camino High in Sacramento, his bests were 1:53.9 in 880, 50.4 in 440 and 21-0 in the long jump. Also did 22.7 in the 220 and 6-4 in the high jump. Graduated in 1969. Running comes naturally for him. His father was a miler at California and his sister, Dino, was one of the top women half-milers in the world several years ago. Also played basketball in high school. College Record. First attended American River College in Sacramento before transfering to Oregon State. Last year did 1:48.1 in 800M, 16th best among collegians in 1972 and converted to an 880 time, equals 1:48.8, which is seventh best ever at OSU. He participated in the Olympic trials last summer and scored 27½ team points during the season, 11th on the team.

JIM MILLER 6-4 215 Freshman 19 Discus

Prep Career: A 1972 graduate of Reynolds High in Portland, Miller was an outstanding football and track athlete. His best effort of 193-10 in the discus is a State record and was the fourth best effort by a prep last year in the country. He also won the State class AAA discus title in the State meets as a junior and senior. Played offensive and defensive tackle and was selected for the Shrine Game last summer. College Career: Played tackle for the OSU Junior Varsity last fall.

JEFF OVESON 6-4 175 Junior 20 Int. Hurdles

Prep Career: High point man in the 1970 Oregon class A meet senior year. Won low hurdles and six month earlier the State cros country title. Also played on Wallowa's State championship basketball team in 1970. His prep bests were 49.7 in 440, 20.0 in 180 LH and 14.0 in the highs. College Career: Ran 53.5 as a freshman in the IH, then improved to 52.4 last year, seventh best ever at OSU. He was second in the Northern Division meet (52.8) and third in Pacific-8 meet (52.6) last year. Scored 38½ points last year, fourth on the team, and has 65¼ in two years. His springy, rangy build, according to Wagner, along with a willingness to run distance workouts, make him an outstanding prospect.

STEVE RIM 6-0 160 Freshman 19 Triple-Long Jump

Prep Career: An outstanding triple jumper from Clovis High, Clovis, California, Rim had the top prep mark in the country last year at 50-10, set at the Golden West Invitational. He also won the Chicago Invitational his senior year. His 50-10 effort was the 40th best in the USA last year (all groups included). Has done 24-7 in the long jump, ninth best prep mark in 1972. Also had the best prep jump in the country as a junior, 48-43/4. Played two years of football and basketball at Clovis. **College Career:** Will be OSU's top triple jumper and long jumper.

Went 13-9 as a prepper. Graduated in 1969. College Career: As a sophomore, scored 21 1/3 points, then added 30 more last year as the Beaver's top vaulter. Did 15-6 as a sophomore and 15-9 last year. Wagner expects him to top the 16 foot mark this year.

DOUG SNYDE 6-0 160 Junior 20 Hurdles

Prep Career: Graduated from Lodi High, Lodi, California in 1970. During senior year was undefeated in dual meet competition over high hurdles. Finished sixth in State meet and set conference record of 14.3. His best that year was 14.2 in HH, 19.4 in LH, 44-9 in riple jump, 20-9 in long jump and 51.8 on relay leg in 440. College Career: Last year was OSU's second high hurdler with a 14.5 best time. Has also done 53.4 in the intermediates. Will be the Beaver's top man in the highs and will also be a scorer in the longer race.

270 Senior Shot Put SPIKE WALKER 5-11 Prep Career: A prep standou' in football, wrestling and track at Battleground High, Walker graduated in 1969. He was all-conference defensive guard, fourth in prep wrestling championships in Washington. Also won State shot put title with a best of 60-8 1/4, top mark in the Pacific Northwest. College Career: Attended Spokane Falls Communiy College, coached by Mike Keller, former graduate assistant at OSU. As a freshman threw 57-31/2 for State record, then set national record with 62-1 heave as a sophomore. That record still stands. Last year broke OSU varsity mark with 61-1 1/2 toss. Scored 33 points, ranked ninth among collegiate shot put specialists. Finished second in Northern Division meet while setting OSU mark. Also owns OSU indoor mark at 59-21/2. Is eyeing record of 62-10 for shot putters under 6-0 in height.

6-5 165 Sophomore 19 High Jump TOM WOODS Prep Career: Oregon high jump record holder at 6-11 1/2, Woods graduated from Estacada High in 1971. Coached by Dick Stiles. Gained prep AA honors as a senior, was named Athlete of the Year at Estacada. Also played basketball. Attended Olympic development camp in Maine following graduation, jumping seven feet. College Career: Achieved more in his first varsity season than most would in a career. Finished the season by taking the NCAA championship at 7-31/4, top mark in the USA in 1972 and the seventh best in the world. Tied Northern Division mark at 7-0 and Bell Field record at same height. Holds Rook mark at 7-31/4. Scored 48 team points last year, second best on the team. Shares National freshman record at 7-31/4 and is the second best high jumper in OSU history. In first indoor appearance of the winter season, Woods went 7-33/4 at the Oregon Indoor Invitational, the top indoor effort in the world this past season. In the same meet, just missed world indoor record when attempted 7-5, catching bar with trailing leg.
