## Administrative Building Block Identified by OSU Researcher

A major advance in understanding the fundamental composition of administrators was reported on Wednesday by Dr. Sven Ugotago-Ugotago of the OSU Department of Administrative Staff Science (Dept. of ASS).  
Dr. Ugotago-Ugotago, a longtime member of the OSU Physics Department, who recently turned his attention to more mundane topics told OSU This Weak about his work in an interview Friday afternoon.  
Ugotago-Ugotago explained that his life long

interest in sub-atomic particles provided a theoretical framework for this most recent finding.  
"Actually," explained Dr. Ugotago-Ugotago, "identifying elementary particles of atoms is quite simple. One puts them into an accelerator, speeds them up to near the speed of light, and collides them together, a process which shatters the atoms into the fundamental building blocks comprising them.  
What I wondered was what would happen if we do similar things with VeePees?"

To test his theory, Dr. Ugotago-Ugotago herded 47 OSU VeePees into a specially constructed vessel capable of withstanding the incredible vacuum created by the presence of so much OSU administration in one place.  
Then, by firing a series of memoes through the chamber, Ugotago-Ugotago accelerated the VeePees to a bureaucratic frenzy. Remarkably, when they began to collide together, the VeePees shattered, not into thousands of subatomic particles the way atoms do, but rather into millions of identical fat amorphous blobs called Quirks.  
Dr. Ugotago-Ugotago postulates that Quirks comprise the fundamental building blocks of a VeePee.

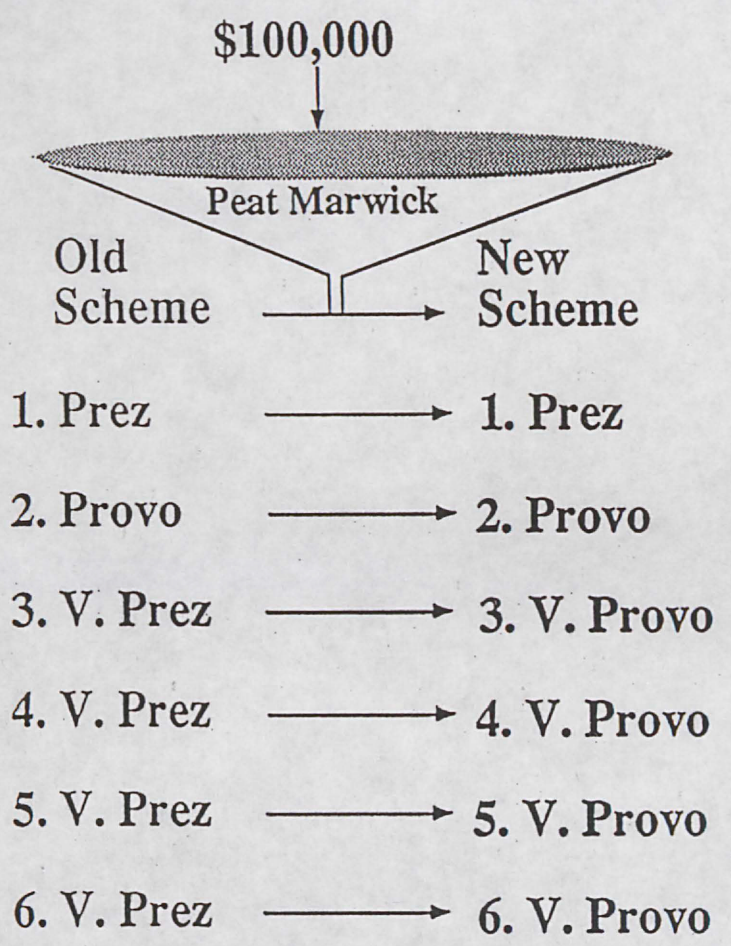
