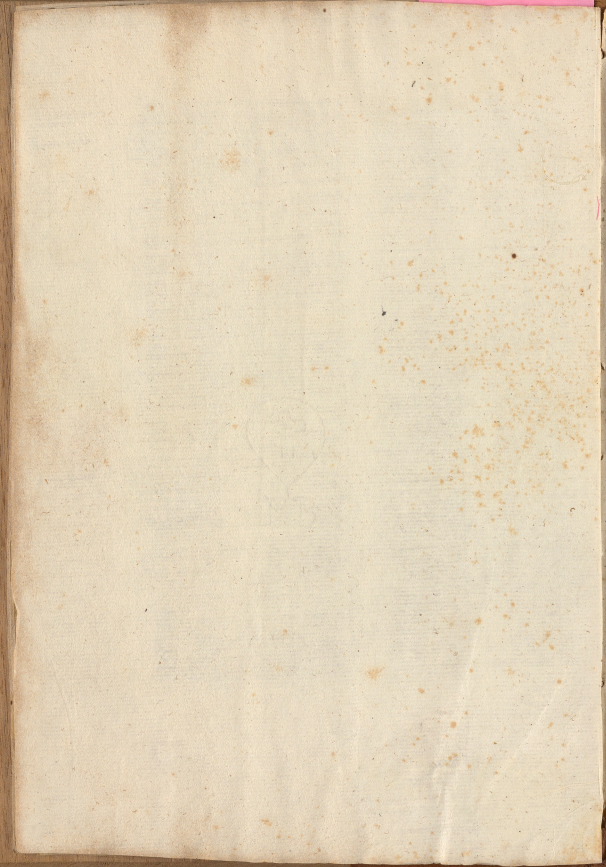

Leav. 12., col. 1 (Incipit matth.)... cum sem-  
per dixerim veritatem. Do. xiiij. ego sum  
via veritas || et via. Rom. iij. Est autem deus  
verax. || Cum semper nos moveam primam  
utilitatem....

Explicit matth. to the v. of the leav. 6., col.  
3:... mittetur. || Notandum quod recur-  
rum philosophus homo arbor euerge  
est. eius capilli.

Goth. caret, very small and curious. 6 unnumbered  
leav. num. 246 x 172. The character shows that  
the ms. was written in the first years  
of the XIII<sup>th</sup> century, and perhaps in the last  
years of the XII century.
